Elementary students must meet the below criteria to obtain Work Ethic Certification for the 2025-2026 school year.

- Attendance criteria Obtain no more than 2 unexcused absences.
- Behavior criteria Incur zero behavior incidents listed in Infinite Campus.
- Academic criteria A student must have a score of basic or above when using standards based report cards or showing progress in the below basic benchmark.
- Giving Back & Getting Involved A student must participate in any two of the following:
 - School/community team or individual sport
 - School/community extra-curricular club activity
 - o Ten hours of community service
