Subject Complements

- 1) **Define -** a noun or adjective that modifies the subject and follows a <u>linking verb</u>
 - PN = noun / pronoun
 - PA = adjective

2) Example -

Tom became a rock star.

- Subject = Tom
- <u>Linking Verb</u> = became
- <u>PN</u> = star

Bob is always late.

- Subject = Bob
- Linking Verb = is
- <u>PA</u> = late

3) Tips:

• Linking Verbs: am, are, is, was, be, being, been, become, smell, look, taste, remain, feel, appear, sound, seem, grow, turn, stand (replace with am, are, is, was???)
