It is advised to read this ToS before commissioning me, as you agree to the terms of service when you commission me and pay the invoice via PayPal.

Important to know:

- I have the right to decline any commission for any reason.
- Clients must be 18 years or older to commission me.
- All payment is done through **PayPal** in **\$USD** (NO CRYPTO!)
- Payment must be received before work begins.
- Certain refunds that can be issued as detailed below.
- None of my artwork may be used in ANY blockchain-related technology, including NFTs, cryptocurrency, or any past, present, or future blockchain-associated technologies.

Client Rights and Art Usage

- Clients retain the right to have a private commission and not uploaded to any galleries.
 - Please let me know in advance!
- Clients can remain anonymous when a commission is posted online to any galleries.
 - Again, please let me know in advance!
- Clients may upload the artwork anywhere they choose AND give credit.
- Clients may NOT use artwork in a commercial setting without discussing it with me beforehand.
- Clients may NOT remove my watermark/signature.
- Clients may NOT use artwork to train AI or use in any sort of relation with AI.
- Clients may NOT claim they made the commission.
- Clients may NOT recolor, trace/copy, heavily edit and/or heavily reference the commission and claim it as their own.

Prices and Payment

- Full payment must be made before starting on the commission.
 - I will not start working until I have received the payment.
- Complexity in design, detail, or backgrounds will increase the price.
 - o Prices listed on the guide are for reference and not a final quote.
- I provide the quote in USD for the commission in our conversation and once it is agreed upon, I will send an invoice via PayPaI.
- Do NOT send me any payment without my consent.

Refunds and Cancellations

- If I cannot finish a commission for any reason (haven't started), I will issue a full refund.
- If you decide not to go through with a commission, and nothing had been drawn, I will issue a full refund or not request payment.
- If you cancel after some work has done, I will do a partial refund, but never a full refund.
 - Ex) A flat colored fullbody was order and was at the linework stage and the client wants to cancel the commission, the client will only receive 20% of the payment they originally made and the finished linework stage drawing (80% is retained for the work done).

Process

- I will reach out to you via your preferred method chosen on the form.
- I will go over what you have ordered and give you a quote.
- Once the quote is agreed upon, an invoice is sent via PayPal.
- Once the invoice is paid, I will start work on a rough sketch.
- The rough sketch will be shown and I will ask if any edits are needed.
 - Please feel free to redline any sketch! I genuinely love redlines!
- Please request any edits early in the commission process (sketch and linework) before I get approval to complete the commission.
- Edits made very close to completion will be charged accordingly.
- You will be sent the high resolution finished piece.
 - Please be sure to save it as I clean my files every few months!

Turnaround Time

- I don't do deadlines as I work on art during my own time and pace.
- Complexity of pieces influences how long each piece can take, with more complex pieces taking longer like a few weeks.
- Generally, I am pretty quick for turnaround times as I only open a small amount of slots at a time!
- I have a Trello queue that can also give you information about your commission status/progress.
 - I also give frequent updates to you if I have done a good amount of work!
- I do not appreciate being pressured to speed up work on a commission and if I feel uncomfortable about it I will let you know
