



ALL East Marshall High School students are eligible and encouraged to take concurrent (Dual-Credit) classes through postsecondary options, including Marshalltown Community College.

SENIOR YEAR PLUS PROGRAM

The senior year plus program provides Iowa high school students access to advanced placement courses and a variety of means by which to concurrently access postsecondary and secondary credit.

Concurrent enrollment courses are made available to ALL High School students, regardless of grade. A list of concurrent enrollment offerings may be requested from the high school counselor. It may also be found in the Iowa Valley Community College course listing.
