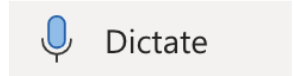
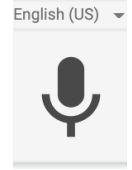


How to Activate Built-In Speech-to-Text Across Platforms

How to Activate	How to use dictation on Windows To open the dictation toolbar, press the Windows logo key  + H. To stop dictating at any time while you're dictating, say "Stop dictation." Using a tablet or touchscreen: Tap the microphone button  on the touch keyboard to start dictation. Tap it again to stop, or just say "stop dictation." <u>Use Dictate on Microsoft Word</u> <u>Q365</u> 	How to use dictation on macOS: Go to Apple Menu>System Preferences > Keyboard> Dictation Press Fn+Fn to dictate, and Fn+Fn to stop How to use dictation on iOS: To enter text, tap the microphone button  on your keyboard, then start speaking. As you speak, the text appears on the screen. To finish, stop speaking, then tap the keyboard button 	Open google Doc Go to Tools Select Voice Typing  Voice typing Click  the microphone icon to speak, and to stop speaking To dictate across websites and GMail VoiceIn Voice Typing Chrome web extension link This speech-to-text extension allows the user to dictate text for any text box or text entry portion of a web page. You can either click the extension or right-click and choose "Start recording" to use it. Be sure to click the extension again to turn off the speech-to-text function when done.
