

Behavior and Conduct at State FFA Convention

- Remember that at all times you are representing yourself, your family, the Mt. Baker FFA Chapter and school, and the Washington State FFA Organization (Please be on your best behavior)
- Any behavior that violates the Mt. Baker FFA Code of Conduct (fighting, extreme drama, being disrespectful to advisors, chaperones or any adult) will be grounds for being sent home immediately and will result in school disciplinary action (Let's come with positive attitudes)
- Any use of tobacco products, alcohol or other illegal substances will be grounds for immediately being sent home at parents expense and will result in school disciplinary action
- School dress code will be followed at all times during the trip – if you have to ask if it's ok to wear it then it probably is not
- Any damage to dorm rooms or any building on campus at WSU will be the responsibility of the student/family to pay before the end of the school year
- Any student that loses their key to the dorm room will be required to pay the fine before leaving WSU campus
- Please remember that we are guests at WSU, so treat everyone with respect including each other
- Make sure to travel in groups around campus...although it is a pretty safe college campus in the summer it is still better to stick together (Make sure to let someone know where you are going)
- No student will be allowed to ride in any forms of transportation not provided by the Mt. Baker School District throughout the trip
- Each student and parent will sign a Code of Conduct Agreement that begins when we leave the high school on May 8th and does not end until we arrive back home on May 12th
- Remember that it is common courtesy to ask permission before borrowing other's belongings
- If you have a problem with someone on the trip please try to deal with the issue directly with that person (do not involve other people)
- All FFA members are to attend all required meetings/business sessions selected by the advisors **(this is not optional and could include individual meetings for boys/girls on the trip)**

Suggested Items to Bring to State FFA Convention

1. Official Dress: Black slacks or skirt (no more than 2" above knee), white collared shirt, FFA Jacket, FFA scarf or tie, black dress shoes, black nylons (several pairs if wearing a skirt) and black socks.

(You are encouraged to bring more than one shirt, skirt or pair of slacks)

2. Casual clothes for trips to and from convention

(All casual clothing must be school appropriate: no lowcut or crop tops, shirts must be three fingers

wide at the shoulder, no underwear showing, no short skirts or shorts, no see-through blouses, no muscle tees or t-shirts with sides cut out, and make sure clothing is freshly washed)

3. Bathroom essentials (travel shampoo, bodywash, deodorant, toothpaste, etc.)

4. Alarm clock or cell phone and charger

5. Iron (not required)

6. towel and washcloth

7. pillow, blanket/sheets or sleeping bag for trip *there are no linens in the dorms.

8. sandals for shower

9. money (4 -5 meals + spending)

10. comfortable walking shoes

11. warm jacket

12. entertainment for the trip to and from Pullman

13. anything needed to participate in your contest (you may be asked to pack items for your CDE)

(study guides or materials should be packed and available for trip to State FFA Convention...you will be studying on the ride over to state)

14. Calculator and pens or pencils

15. water bottle
