Context

This initiative aims to track the ongoing progress and existing deliverables from approved proposals on **OpenGov**.

How? By developing a user-friendly easy to navigate interface that will offer Polkadot users & voters an insightful clear overview of each proposal's status while creating an extra layer of accountability and responsibility for those entrusted with treasury funding.

In short, it's about providing everyone a straightforward and transparent environment to monitor completed tasks, current developments, deadlines & overall performance or upgrades in real-time with presented data & valuable informative context all gathered in one well organised place.

Problem Statement

-OpenGov Fatigue

Due to the high number of OpenGov proposals and with many more popping up on a regular basis it's very difficult for voters to keep track of everything that is happening post approval.

- Not meeting expectations

Proposals end up under-delivered or underperformed without the Polkadot audience knowing about this situation and being able to evaluate in future attempts.

- Lack of awareness

It's extremely hard for the community to be aware all the time of the current state or deadlines of each proposal.

- Important information is frequently lost

Past events from notable achievements to unmet promises or expected developments are being forgotten and remain untraceable. Community often forgets what happened or what to expect.

-Absence of an all-in-one platform for that cause

We are missing a dedicated place that systematically offers detailed information for each proposal, tracks historical events, and revisits them for reevaluation. This allows us also to extract feedback and learn from past experience.

Solution

Create a user-friendly well-organised interface for visibility and full transparency.

Benefits

- The UI design is simple, intuitive, and easy to navigate.
- Provide throughout reviews of the current situation.
- Enable voters to understand ongoing developments and always be up to date on each proposal.
- If a proponent submits another proposal, the community and voters will have his proof of work with detailed information for evaluation.
- Background information on each proponent, including the progress and impact of their ideas or proposals.
- Clear system to track & display the status of deliverables fast and easy.
- Maintaining communication with recipients, providing updates on the current status or any encountered obstacles.

Project overview

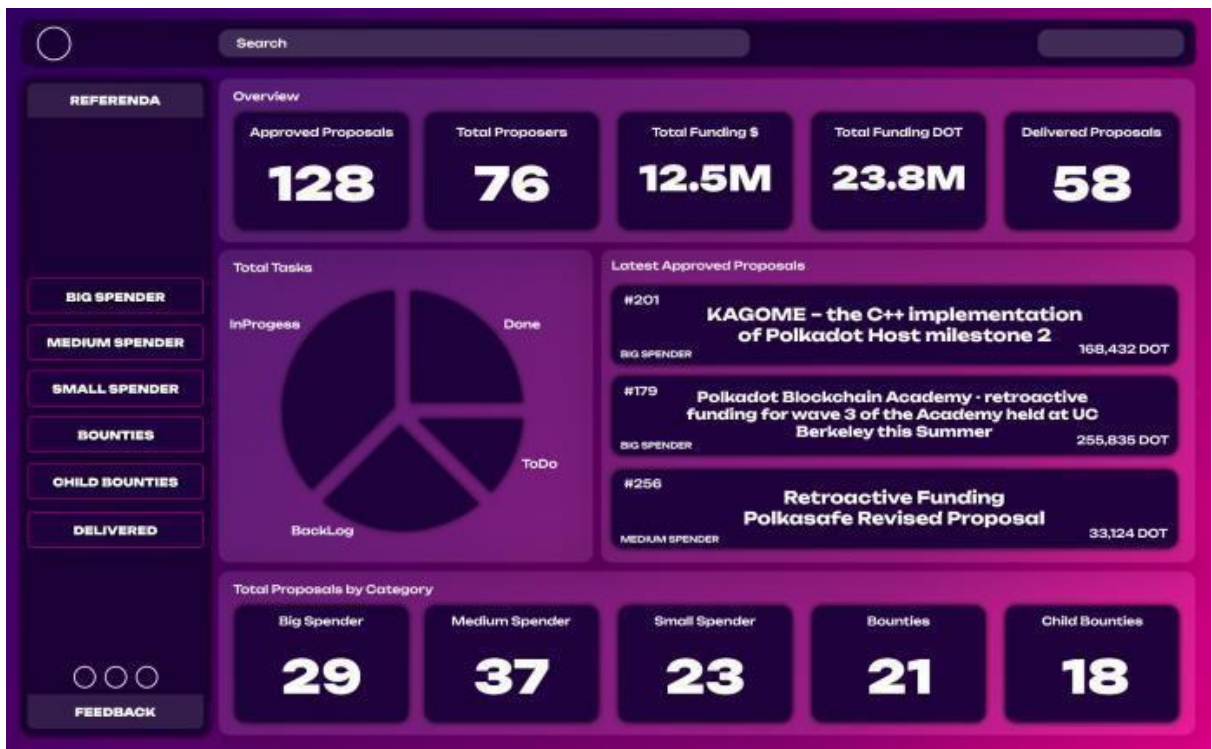
At a glance this is how the final product would look like. We will divide the interface into three main sections where the user can learn and be informed about the progress of OpenGov approved proposals on Polkadot.

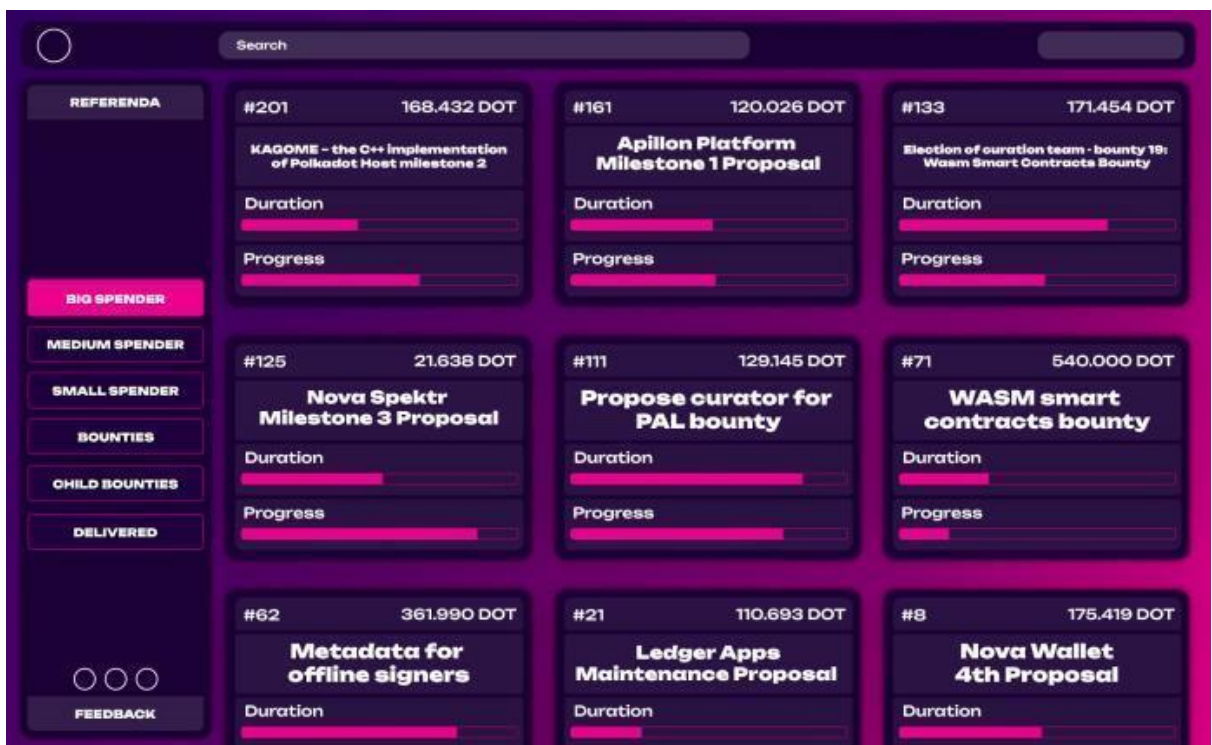
Home Dashboard

Tracking process

We identified a straightforward and efficient workflow that we will follow as a core guide to assist us throughout the entire process:

-Proposal breakdown & analysis

Read carefully each proposal by highlighting milestones and expected deliverables based on proposed duration and deadlines.

-Information Gathering

Track and collect all the necessary information from different sources such as Github, X, Website, Youtube etc to examine if they met the expectations.

-Communication with teams

Communicate with involved teams for extra confirmations or additional information when not publicly available..

Here are some more specific examples on various types of proposals:

For proposals related to content marketing, where the proponent requests funding for a specific amount of content delivered within a specific timeframe. We will monitor their social media accounts to define their progress and the validity of their deadline. Also, we will

present data with metrics about their traction and engagement rates to assess their overall impact.

For proposals that involve upgrades of an existing project or the development of a new one we will primarily gather all the necessary information by monitoring their GitHub for code commits, new issues, and pull requests as everything is open source. As a next step we will reach out to the teams for extra input if needed or additional information about any obstacles they might have faced and resulted in delays.

When it comes to approved tips or general forkless upgrades into the chain, they will be directly included in the Delivered category and we will provide a brief and straightforward summary as a reference to keep everyone updated.

All relevant information will be displayed clearly on the OG Tracker interface for easy access and transparency.

Future plans

The end-game goal of OG Tracker is to be a collaborative open tool where all parties entrusted with funding will be able to report their progress by themselves in our interface autonomously.

In addition OG Tracker will go on-chain with community members being able to evaluate each proposal on a credibility scoreboard by voting with their Substrate addresses.

As this is our first time asking for funding we aim to demonstrate our work and our capabilities, showcase our efficiency and establish our presence within the community.

Milestone 1

Estimated Duration 2 months

During Milestone 1 we will work towards the web development & web design of the OG Tracker along with the collection of all the data about existing approved proposals, formation of the context for the interface & completion of reaching-out to teams in case adequate information is not available.

At the end of Milestone 1 the interface will be finalised, production-ready and fully operational with all the research, writing & communication related tasks being completed and displayed in the UI.

Milestone 2

Estimated Duration 2 months

In Milestone 2 our focus will be on maintenance optimizations of the interface and the extra implementation & tracking of updates in-real time on the ongoing or new proposals that might occur. During this phase we also seek to gather valuable feedback, monitor our results and collect the data of our own performance.

We strongly believe that OG Tracker is a very simple yet extremely useful tool that will bring significant value to our ecosystem.
