## **Evergreen Cares Clinic**

Greater Valley Health Center (GVHC) is a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) committed to serving our community with medical, dental, behavioral health, and substance use treatment services *regardless of ability to pay*. We offer services throughout Flathead County. Our mission is to improve the health outcomes throughout the greater Flathead Valley by providing *exceptional, compassionate, integrated, and accessible patient-centered care* to all.

Evergreen Cares Clinic, a school-based health clinic, is an outreach program of GVHC. GVHC is extending our services to the staff, students, and families of Evergreen School District. You may receive these services without giving up your own primary care doctor, or you may use the clinic as your primary care provider. The clinic wants to provide what you need when you need it.

### **Medical and Mental/Behavioral Health Services**

- Schedule visits with staff by calling ahead:
  - 406-607-4900: Greater Valley Health Center (to make an appointment)
  - On site physicians, advanced practice providers, or resident services are available as follows:
    - Second and fourth Mondays 1:00-5:00 p.m. and Tuesdays 8:00am-5:00pm
- On site licensed mental health provider services are available by referral.
- Telehealth visits are available by calling 607-4900:
  - Monday-Friday (same day visits often available)
- Service hours will be expanded as the need for service increases.

### **Services Available**

- Well child checks (including immunizations and sports physicals)
- Lab draws
- Rapid COVID, strep, and flu testing
- Prescribing over the counter and prescription medications
- Diagnosis and treatment of sudden conditions, including first aid
- Monitoring and treatment of chronic medical needs
- Psychiatry
- Dental referrals
- Mental or behavioral health services, including screening, assessment, and counseling/treatment
- Referrals for health services not provided at this clinic
- Annual wellness exams

**Enrollment (click on the blue links below for enrollment forms)**

Become a patient of Evergreen Cares Clinic by completing the enrollment packet, which includes a Registration Form, a Consent for Service, and a Release of Information form.

[Patient Registration Form \(Non-student\)](#) [Patient Registration Form \(Student\)](#) – Enrolls you as a patient of Greater Valley Health Center, Inc. The form includes questions we need to capture because we are an FQHC. Once you complete the form, your record will be maintained in their electronic medical record. Those records are available only to your medical provider and not to school personnel.

[Consent for Service](#) – Indicates your consent for service for your child. The consent provides guidance to the services staff can provide if you come to the clinic. Only the services on the consent will be provided unless services staff make direct contact with you and obtain verbal consent.

[Release of Information Form](#) – Allows services staff to release your medical record information to another provider. If you have a primary care provider, signing this form will allow services staff to send a record of your visit to your primary care provider so that he or she is aware of the care you received.

**Billing**

GVHC will bill Healthy Montana Kids, Medicaid, Medicare, and most insurance companies. Copayments and deductibles will be billed to the guarantor. A sliding fee scale is available with proof of income:

GVHC has staff available to assist students and families with enrollment in medicaid or the insurance marketplace.

**Prescription Services**

Providers will be able to write prescriptions for over the counter and prescription medications. Prescriptions may be sent to any local pharmacy.

Many medications are available at a very low price such as insulin and inhalers - most \$4 a month through Syke's.
