How many people are getting ready to go to war in the US military?	Page 88 -Banks are open 24/7 run by robots -Radio says a million soldiers ready for war, Faber says it's 10 million -Guy is getting \$ Faber wanted so they can give it to printer- copy books
Why is Guy concerned about following Faber's directions?	-Guy doesn't want to be a blind sheep just doing whatever Faber says just like he did whatever society told him before -Faber says by saying that, Guy is already thinking for himself -Faber reads to Guy through the seashells (walkie-talkie ear-buds)
Who are Mrs. Phelps and Mrs. Bowles?	Page 89 - Mrs. Phelps and Mrs. Bowles come to visit Mildred -Tv shows- violent
What job does Mrs. Phelps have and how does she cope with it?	-Guy turns off tv and asks ladies about their husbands -Mrs. Phelps on 3 rd marriage, husband Pete in army- if one of them dies they just remarry -Mrs. Phelps no kids, Mrs. Bowles 2 kids
How does Mrs. Bowles describe the raising of her children?	Page 92 Kids -Mrs. Bowles has c-sections instead of natural birth
