New Crisis and Suicide Lifeline

The Crisis and Suicide Lifeline is now available by calling or texting 988. This confidential service is available 24/7. Users may also use the chat function at www.988lifeline.org.

Suicide was the second-leading cause of death among Ohio youth ages 10-14 in 2023, according to the 2023 Ohio Suicide Report, which was recently released by the Ohio Department of Health. The 988 Suicide and Crisis Lifeline is a valuable resource that can help teachers and other school personnel feel better equipped to handle potential mental health challenges before they escalate to a crisis.

Historically, Ohio has promoted the use of the Crisis Text Line and asked help-seekers to text 4HOPE to 741741; however, 988 provides a more local response and offers more ways to reach out for help. With the ability to call, text, or chat through 988Lifeline.org, students can connect in the most comfortable way for them. We appreciate your support in this state and national effort to raise awareness of this easy-to-remember, three-digit number that provides 24/7 free and confidential support.

Safer Ohio School Tip Line

We continue to be registered with The Ohio School Safety Center (OSSC) to utilize the <u>Safer Ohio School Tip Line</u>, a free resource available to Ohio schools. This system allows students and adults to anonymously share information via phone and text with school officials and law enforcement about threats to student safety. The system is available 24/7/365 by text and phone at 844-SaferOH (844-723-3764) and is answered by analysts within Ohio Homeland Security who immediately forward the information to school officials, law enforcement agencies, and the OSSC. The OSSC partners with the Ohio Department of Education to ensure the incident is investigated, action is taken, and resources/supports are provided when necessary.
