Event Kit Inventory & Guide

This guide outlines the contents of our event kit and offers suggestions for utilizing the included materials. Please note that event requirements vary across councils, so you will need to adapt these recommendations to suit your specific event. Feel free to use as much or as little of the kit as you deem necessary. Our primary goal is to promote the Fraternity and cultivate prospective members.

It should take 15-20 min to set up

We aim to maintain two to three of these kits available for loan. All components fit within the box and should be returned therein. While we will strive for consistency, please note that minor variations may exist between boxes. If any item is missing, please inform the alumni association.



Your kit will include a return shipping label. You should find it in a pouch on the inside flap of the box. Please keep this label so you can return the kit to us. Also save the box!



Kit Contents

Table Cloth

QTY 1



Included is an eight-foot, double-sided tablecloth. One side displays the APO Eagles logo, while the other features the Alpha Phi Omega letters. You will need to determine which side to use based on your audience.

Because this is an 8-foot tablecloth, you will need to be careful centering it on a 6-foot table. Please ensure that tails do not cause a trip hazard.

QR Blocks

QTY 3



You should find three clear blocks, each with a different QR code.

- The "swag block" is key for gathering student information; students should scan it when receiving swag.
- For alumnus/alumna visits, they should fill out the **alumni check-in** form.
- The chapter finder block links you to the national website, where you can search for a school

Some blocks have experimental NFC tags. If the QR codes aren't working, the websites are listed at the bottom of the blocks.

Hanging Included are two hanging banners one for the Banners Fraternity and one for the Alumni Association. Use the most appropriate one or use both. You'll need QTY 2 some way to hang them or attach them to the wall. Patch Displays

Included are three 11x17 display sets showcasing various patches produced by the alumni association and the Fraternity over time.

These patch displays should be used in conjunction with the "Support the Scholarship" posters to create a mini store. The QR code, located in the bottom right-hand corner of the poster, directs individuals to our alumni association store. There, they can order any, all, or some of the patches displayed on the table, pay by credit card, and have them shipped directly to their address. The sets provided in the boxes are for display purposes only and will need to be reused at multiple events; therefore, please do not sell the items displayed on the table.

Swag

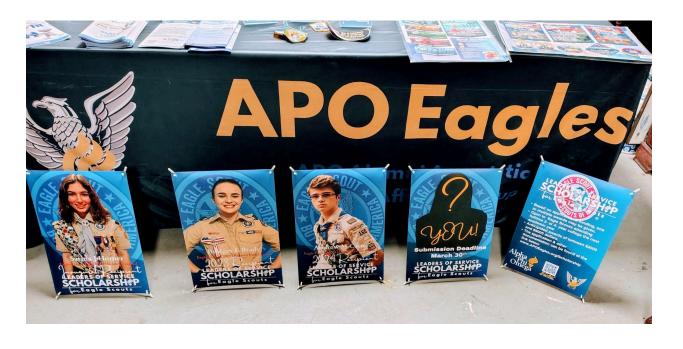


Currently, there are two versions of our handout document. The older version is an 8.5 x 11-inch sheet folded in half, containing information solely about the fraternity and the opportunity it presents.

The newer style is an oversized tri-fold encompassing three distinct documents. When placed on the table, it presents the Fraternity opportunity; flipping it over reveals the invitation to the Leaders of Service Scholarship program. Opening it fully displays the Leaders of Service Scholarship handout. Additionally, there are three piles of what appear to be three different single-page documents, suitable for both students and parents.
