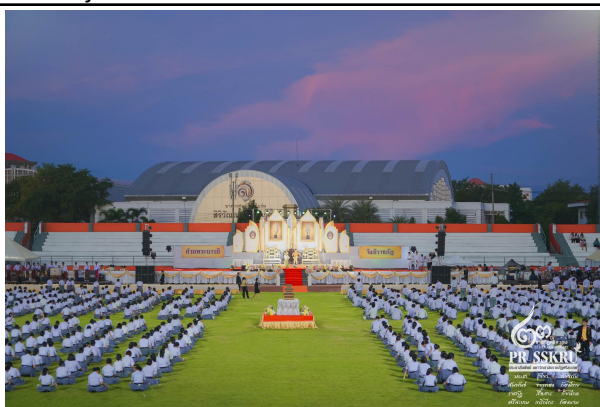

4. The skill to create innovations to solve problems for the local community.
