

1. Download the Google Classroom app to your phone
2. For PlayStation
 1. Identify the PlayStation internet browser icon (WWW with dots around it).
 2. Press the PlayStation logo on the controller.
 3. Go to the library and find options for games and applications.
 4. Go to applications and you will find the internet browser.
 5. Navigate to your online learning platform and log in as usual.

3. For Xbox

1. Plug a keyboard into the Xbox USB slot.
2. Go to my games and apps.
3. Find and select Microsoft Edge.
4. Navigate to your online learning platform.

4. Project from your Apple device to your TV to see a bigger view of your work.

5. Cast video to your Android TV

Cast content from your device to your TV

Important: You can only cast from the latest version of a [Chromecast-enabled app](#) or a [Chrome browser](#) on a device connected to the same Wi-Fi network as the Android TV.

1. Connect your device to the [same Wi-Fi network](#) as your Android TV.
2. Open the app that has the content that you want to cast.
3. In the app, find and select Cast .
4. On your device, select the name of your TV.
5. When Cast  changes colour, you're successfully connected.
