GENERAL INFORMATION

We offer two levels of electrician courses through our Lakeland/BTPS partnership, when student interest permits. Through participation in these courses, students will learn about the electrical trade, even with no previous experience in the trade. All courses give access to Lakeland College's 'state of the art' shops and are taught by ticketed instructors.

Electrician courses are not leveled. Level 1 has a Residential Electrical focus whereas Level 2 has an Industrial Magnetic Electrical Field focus. We encourage students to take both levels so that they have exposure to both fields, as this will assist students in making an informed decision about which route to pursue if interested in an electrical trade.

COURSE HOURS

The classrooms at Lakeland open at 8:15 and classes begin at 8:30 a.m. sharp. Class runs until 12:00 (noon), and students are given a half hour break for lunch with class resuming at 12:30 and ending at 3:30 p.m. In the case of a condensed week or the need to alter the schedule, class times might change to 8:30 a.m. and run until 4:00 p.m. each day. (the instructor or school will further inform students of details)

OTHER USEFUL INFORMATION

- Students are required to wear appropriate clothing; coveralls, steel-toed safety boots and safety goggles for mechanics, electrical, carpentry and welding courses.
- Students are welcome to eat at the Lakeland cafeteria, but should be warned that it is very busy during the lunch hour and students may not have time to order and eat food and be back in class by 12:30. It is recommended that students bring lunch.
- On the first day of classes, a Lakeland representative will meet students at the back of the Trades Centre at the large door #10 labeled 'Automotive' (if not otherwise directed). For directions to this location, view the aerial photo in the student package online.
- Parking is available for students on the southeast side of the Trades building.
- Binders containing electrician manuals for students will be housed at Lakeland College's Vermilion campus.
