Because you have this document in your hands, because you are reading this, you are already a teammate.

"Let me tell you about teammates. From The Tour de France.

This is what the Teammate Creed is: You show up on time.

Anyplace and anytime you show up, you show up on time, and the reason why is it tells everybody that the relationship is more important than ME doing what I want.

When people feel like that, they will give everything that they have to HONOR that privilege." - Dr. Jeff Spencer, Cornerman

So when you step into The Arena, you are doing so *as a* **teammate.** Show up. Take action. Because others are watching and how you do this *matters*.

Here's The Arena:

"I did this and here's what happened"

The Arena is presented primarily, structurally, as live workshops where you share with The Guardian Academy Team what you are working on, and receive Clarity on the next best step for you to take.

We call this simply:

"I did this and here's what happened."

You show up, tell us what you did and what happened, and we help you figure out your next steps. The next Arena you show up and again tell us what you did and what happened.

If you show a pattern of joining The Arena and not taking action, you will be removed. This isn't punishment but for your own well being.

The Arena isn't a place to gain information, it's a place to TAKE ACTION.

The action doesn't have to be "good" or "correct."

It just has to be.

There's no judgement or superiority in The Arena - it's all just Data.

"I did this and here's what happened" turns into "great, based on what you want, try this next."

Everything is oriented around taking "the idea" and putting it into Action.

This is "Engaging The Field."

- To begin with, there will be 1 Arena session per month. That session will last as long as it needs to last. Whoever shows up with Action gets to speak and be heard.
- You will also receive 1 ticket to a TGA Event (and a discounted opportunity for Grey Wolf Summit), where you can experience full presence and take your Action a step further.

The Full Arena schedule is not yet written in stone. For our first cohort we will likely choose our times based on what's best for our *early action takers*.

If that sounds like *not* enough certainty for you, DON'T JOIN NOW - just watch.

Some of The Arena sessions will be broadcast live, free, so you can see what the experience is like.
