NEW UPDATES

First Day of School:

- School starts Wednesday, August 30.
- We'll be waiting to welcome our Grade 1 to 8 Wildcats at the Edgerly Building at 8 Bonair St.

Transportation:

We have secured shuttle buses to help provide transportation from 115 Sycamore St. to and from Edgerly and Capuano. Due to the limited number of seats, students will be selected based on eligibility. We will share more next week as we finalize capacity and plans. For all families: resources and maps, as well as information about free MBTA passes are now available online, here. Building Tours:

SPS staff will provide short, small-group tours of some spaces within the Edgerly (not all, due to time constraints). Tours will leave from the Bonair St. accessible entrance (near Cross St.) To join a tour, please arrive during scheduled hours and be prepared to wait briefly.

Entrances at Edgerly Building

There are 4 entrances to Edgerly. To help clarify when to use each option, here's a quick guide:

NAME OF ENTRANCE	LOCATION	WHEN TO USE
8 Bonair St.	Bonair St., further from Cross St. (no ADA ramp)	"Main Entrance." For visitors, and students who arrive late.
		* Those needing accessible entrance should use the entrance closest to Cross St. That entrance is also close to the indoor elevator.
4 Bonair St.	Bonair St., at Cross St. intersection	 Students being dropped off by buses. This is also the accessible entrance for the building.
Otis St. at Cross St.	Otis St., at Cross St. intersection	Mainly used for 7th/8th grade student entrance.
