**Topics Addressed/Skills Developed:** *Students will explore art-making through the use of technology.* Students will develop skills to create and manipulate digital art with the iPad, Apple pencil, and apps, and iMacs with Adobe Creative Cloud software. The class covers a wide range of Media Arts including: digital art, animation, illustration, motion graphics, character design, graphic design, and more!

**Approximate or range of hours of homework per class meeting:** Homework is rarely assigned for this class, the work is done during class time.
