Too

всегда стоит перед прилагательным или наречием

You speak too fast

Enough

всегда стоит после прилагательного или наречия

You speak fast enough

Noun

Too + many/much + noun

После too всегда стоит

many или much, и только

потом - идет существительное

Enough + noun

Enough всегда стоит перед существительным. Дополнительных слов не нужно

There are too many people here

I have enough time
