- Ceremony #3: 3p-4p (Last Names: Mooney-Z)
  - Graduates lineup at 2 p.m.
  - Families sit in bleachers (all 4 people must have grad ticket upon entrance)
  - All graduates and families must vacate the property by 4:30 pm
- Graduation Guest List Due Date: Friday, May 14th (Coming Soon)
  - Graduates may invite up to four guests to the graduation ceremony.
  - Guests must live within 120 miles of the school.
  - If a name is not submitted on the guest list, entrance into the ceremony will be denied.
