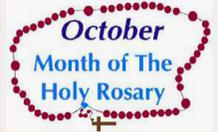

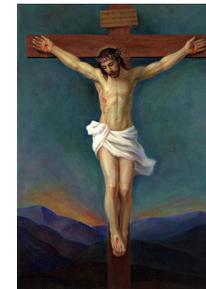

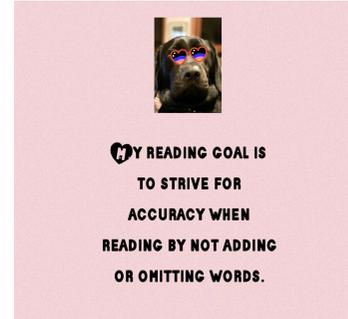

Learning Intention: We are learning to understand the difference between key ideas and details in a text so that we can write a clear summary.

Go to the Seesaw activity titled: Key Ideas wk3T4.

Key ideas are the main points in a text.

Details are elaborations, explanations or examples of the key ideas.

A summary of a text focuses on the key ideas and leaves out the details.

Listen, reflect and evaluate your reading. Comment on whether you have been successful in achieving your goal.

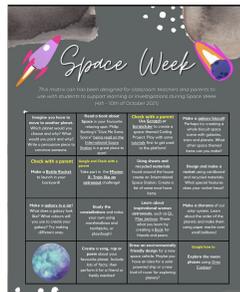
