**Re: Request for Investigation into Potential Violations of 18 U.S.C. § 201**

Dear Officers,

I respectfully request that your offices investigate whether President Donald J. Trump has violated 18 U.S.C. § 201, by pardoning Paul Walczak, after President Trump allegedly received gifts from Mr. Walczak's family.

Federal law strictly prohibits a public official from accepting anything of value in return for being influenced in the performance of any official act.<sup>1</sup> An official act includes any decision or action in a matter before any public official.<sup>2</sup> A pardon is an official act vested to the President by the Constitution.<sup>3</sup>

On April 11, 2025, Mr. Walczak was sentenced to 18 months in prison and ordered to pay more than \$4.3 million in restitution for willfully failing to pay employment taxes and willfully failing to file income tax returns.<sup>4</sup> Rather than paying taxes to the Internal Revenue Service, Mr. Walczak lived a life of luxury – including buying a \$2 million yacht.<sup>5</sup> At his sentencing, a U.S. District Court Judge emphasized that letting Mr. Walczak off the hook “reinforces the perception that the rich get away with it and the poor go to prison.”<sup>6</sup>

Yet, less than two weeks after receiving his prison sentence, on April 23, 2025, President Trump pardoned Mr. Walczak.<sup>7</sup>

This pardon did not happen in a vacuum. There was an escalating series of favors from Mr. Walczak's family to Mr. Trump and his campaigns.<sup>8</sup>

- Mr. Walczak's mother, Elizabeth Fago, raised millions of dollars for President Trump's campaign and for other Republicans.<sup>9</sup>
- Ms. Fago hosted at least three fundraisers for President Trump's campaigns.<sup>10</sup>
- Ms. Fago assisted in the effort to undermine the campaign of President Trump's political opponent, by publicizing the diary of former President Joseph R. Biden's daughter.<sup>11</sup>
  - Ms. Fago allegedly said that she thought publishing the diary would help President Trump win the election.<sup>12</sup>
  - Ms. Fago hosted a fundraiser attended by Donald Trump Jr. at her home in Florida, where representatives of President Trump's campaign viewed the diary<sup>13</sup> and pages of the diary were passed around to attendees.<sup>14</sup>
- Ms. Fago was invited to and attended a \$1 million-a-person fundraising dinner that promised face-to-face access to President Trump at Mar-a-Lago.<sup>15</sup>

President Trump's recent pardons are out of sync with the apolitical guidelines established by the Department of Justice.<sup>16</sup> Indeed, this is not the first time that others have questioned whether President Trump pardoned individuals in exchange for favors or gifts.<sup>17</sup> During President Trump's first term, his administration was investigated by the Department of Justice for a "possible bribery-for-pardon scheme."<sup>18</sup>

In short, it appears that President Trump may be accepting political favors and gifts in exchange for grants of clemency, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 201. I ask the Office of Government Ethics
