Abrosexual

A term wherein one's sexual orientation fluctuates over time. One may be completely asexual one day, and then bisexual or sapphic the next, then pansexual the day after, for example.



Achillean

A romantic or sexual orientation wherein a non-woman is primarily attracted to non-women; more commonly known as the more inclusive form of gay men, although it could also be used as an umbrella term for masc-aligned attraction.


Example: Omnisexuals with a preference towards men and nonbinary people.



Aegoromantic

A romantic orientation under the aromantic spectrum wherein one experiences a disconnect between romantic attraction and romantic fantasies.


Example: Fantasizing about a romantic relationship in an idealistic manner, but is indifferent or repulsed at the idea of engaging in real romantic relationships.



<u>Aegosexual</u>


A sexual orientation under the asexual spectrum wherein one experiences a disconnect between sexual attraction and arousal/fantasy; oftentimes one feels indifferent or repulsed at the concept of physical sex but engaging in sexual fantasies.

Example: Fantasizing about engaging in sexual activity with a faceless individual, but being indifferent to real sexual relationships outside of said fantasies.



Alloromantic

A romantic orientation wherein one is not on the aromantic spectrum and thus can feel romantic attraction towards others.



Aromantic

A romantic orientation wherein one experiences little to no romantic attraction.

Aromantic is a spectrum/umbrella term as well as its own label.



<u>B</u>

Biromantic

A romantic orientation wherein one experiences romantic attraction towards two (or more) genders.



Bisexual

A sexual orientation wherein one experiences sexual attraction towards two (or more) genders.



<u>C</u>


Cupioromantic

A romantic orientation wherein one desires the idea of a romantic relationship but feels little to no romantic attraction.



Cupiosexual


A sexual orientation wherein one desires the idea of a sexual relationship but feels little to no sexual attraction.



<u>D</u>


Demiromantic

A romantic orientation wherein one cannot feel romantic attraction until an emotional bond has been established.




Demisexual

A sexual orientation wherein one cannot feel sexual attraction until an emotional bond has been established.



Diamoric


A romantic or sexual orientation wherein a nonbinary individual experiences attraction to others in a way that cannot be described by the binary of straight or gay.

Enbian


A romantic or sexual orientation wherein a nonbinary (enby) person is attracted to other nonbinary people, either exclusively or in conjunction with attraction to other genders.

<u>Fictosexual</u>

A sexual orientation under the asexual umbrella wherein one is primarily or exclusively attracted to fictional characters.



<u>G</u>

Gynesexual

A sexual orientation wherein one, of any gender, feels sexual attraction towards women and/or femininity.



<u>H</u>

Heteroqueer

A romantic orientation wherein one is attracted to the gender opposite or different to their own



<u>Heterosexual</u>

A sexual orientation wherein one is attracted to the gender opposite or different to their own

Kymenic

A term wherein one's orientation is fixed/static, so whatever gender(s) one is attracted to does not change, although the intensity of that attraction may still fluctuate. An opposite term to orientations such as abrosexual or homoflexible.

Lesbian

A romantic or sexual orientation wherein a non-man is primarily attracted to non-men; more commonly known as a woman who is exclusively attracted to women.



Lesboy
A romantic or sexual orientation wherein a masc-gendered individual is attracted to fem-gendered individuals in a gay/queer way.


<u>N</u>

Nebularomantic

A neurodivergent-exclusive orientation similar to quoiromantic, wherein one has difficulty differentiating between platonic and romantic attraction.


Nebularose

A neurodivergent-exclusive orientation wherein one has difficulty differentiating between and/or identifying platonic, romantic, and sexual attraction. A combination of nebularomantic and nebulasexual.




Nebulasexual

A neurodivergent-exclusive orientation similar to quoisexual, wherein one has difficulty identifying feelings of sexual attraction.



Neptunic

A romantic or sexual orientation wherein one is attracted to fem-aligned and neutral genders, regardless of one's own gender identity



<u>O</u>


Omnisexual

A sexual orientation wherein one is attracted to all genders, but gender plays a factor into one's attraction, such as a preference or differing type of attraction.



Oriented Aroace


An aroace identity wherein one feels significant tertiary attraction towards others.



<u>P</u>

Panromantic

A romantic orientation wherein one is attracted to all genders, with no preference or distinction in their attraction between different genders.




Pansexual

A sexual orientation wherein one is attracted to all genders in such a way that gender doesn't play a difference into their attraction towards people or influence how their attraction manifests.




Polysexual

A sexual orientation and/or umbrella term wherein one feels sexual attraction to multiple genders. Alternatively, one is attracted to nearly all genders with the exception of one or multiple.



Pomoromantic

A romantic orientation wherein one deliberately refuses to label and define that part of their identity.



<u>Q</u>

Queerplatonic

A relationship or partnership term used to describe a relationship or partner that is more than a friend, but not necessarily in a romantic or sexual way.



Quoiromantic

A romantic orientation under the aromantic spectrum wherein one is uncertain about their romantic orientation, refuses to label such, or is confused about the concept of romantic attraction.



Quoisexual


A sexual orientation under the asexual spectrum wherein one is uncertain about their sexual orientation, refuses to label such, or is confused about the concept of sexual attraction.

Rosemantic


A romantic orientation akin to demiromantic, wherein one cannot feel romantic attraction unless a sexual bond (sexual activity or attraction) has been established.



<u>S</u>

A romantic or sexual orientation wherein a non-man is primarily attracted to non-men; more commonly known as the more inclusive form of lesbian, although it could also be used as an umbrella term for fem-aligned attraction.

Example: Omnisexuals with a preference towards women and nonbinary people.


