Advent wreath

The liturgy does not provide for any ritual for an Advent wreath other than the blessing of an Advent wreath (see Book of Blessings), which may take place after the homily at the first Mass of Advent. In some places, additional attention is given to the wreath in the liturgy for cultural and/or pastoral reasons.
