The students will also show their mastery of Photoshop by applying filters to their Photos. The students will show their mastery of a digital camera by taking pictures to use for the assignment. Rules of Composition will be used to take Photos that are to be used for the assignment. Students will turn in 54" x 6" jpg files, 300 resolution, original digital prints.

Different filters will be applied to each of the four prints on the canvas. The student will turn in 5-4" x 6" jpg files, 300 res, original prints.
