### **Radical Inclusion**

Anyone may be a part of Burning Man. We welcome and respect the stranger. No prerequisites exist for participation in our community.

### **Gifting**

Burning Man is devoted to acts of gift giving. The value of a gift is unconditional. Gifting does not contemplate a return or an exchange for something of equal value.

### **Decommodification**

In order to preserve the spirit of gifting, our community seeks to create social environments that are unmediated by commercial sponsorships, transactions, or advertising. We stand ready to protect our culture from such exploitation. We resist the substitution of consumption for participatory experience.

### **Radical Self-reliance**

Burning Man encourages the individual to discover, exercise and rely on their inner resources.

### **Radical Self-expression**

Radical self-expression arises from the unique gifts of the individual. No one other than the individual or a collaborating group can determine its content. It is offered as a gift to others. In this spirit, the giver should respect the rights and liberties of the recipient.

### **Communal Effort**

Our community values creative cooperation and collaboration. We strive to produce, promote and protect social networks, public spaces, works of art, and methods of communication that

support such interaction.

### **Civic Responsibility**

We value civil society. Community members who organize events should assume responsibility for public welfare and endeavor to communicate civic responsibilities to participants. They must also assume responsibility for conducting events in accordance with local, state and federal laws.

### **Participation**

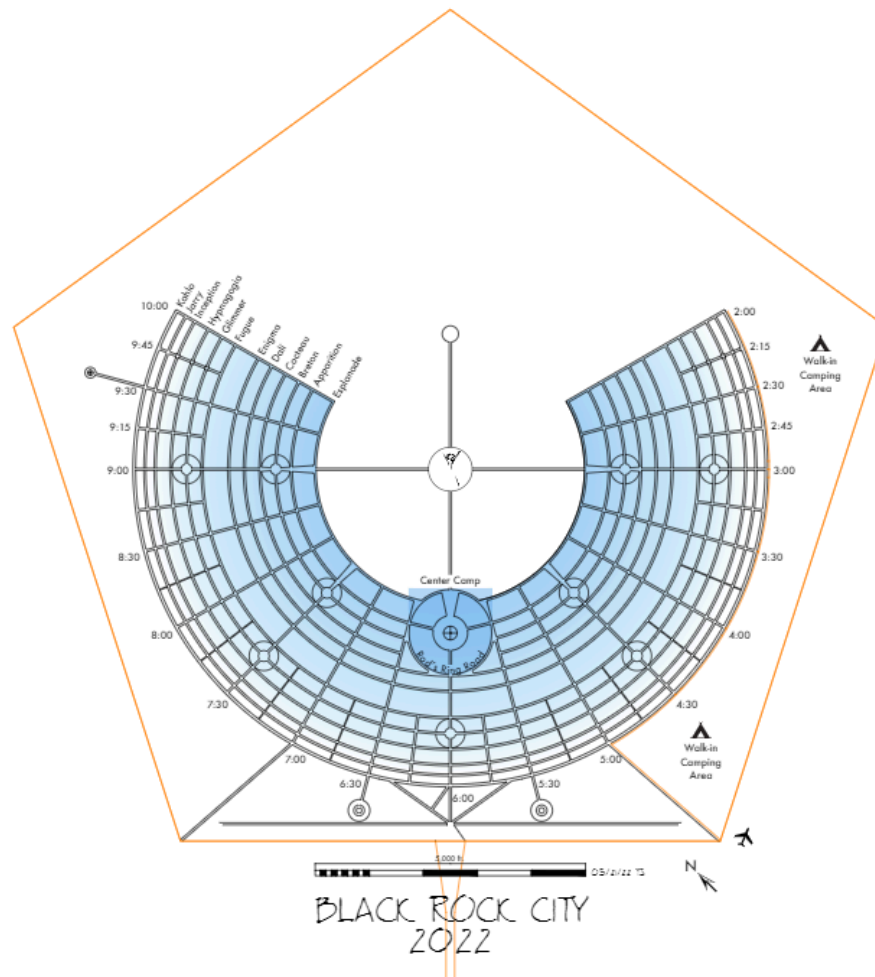

### **Immediacy**

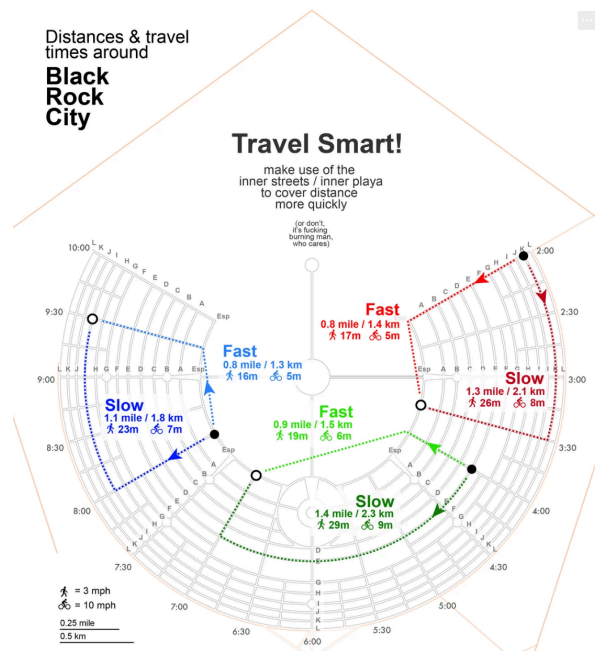

## Map

Here is the map. The radial streets are times on a clock with 12 pointing towards the temple 6 at center camp. The man is in the middle. The other streets are labeled a-z as you go further out. The streets with lamps on them are 12,3,6,9 and esplanade. Please familiarize yourself with the map so you get lost less. Main sound camps are at 2 and 10 oclock and the center street is called Esplanada. We are at 800 D in 2025 can you find it on the map. Find good land marks that will enable you to find your way home. Make sure your landmark is something that doesn't move.







## Camp rules/info

### Oy oy:

Pack call. When this is said you repeat it. This helps identify the group, especially at night, or during a dust storm. If the group needs to stop and change direction someone says OY OY and everyone knows to pay attention and group up. If we have any stragglers this helps locate us.

### Front left

If you go to any sound camp with any sort of stage and you want to find our group you will find us at the front left of the stage. It's the front left of the stage when looking at the stage.

### Camp bar

The camp bar is mainly for when we have interactivities at our camp. This is NOT your main source of alcohol. You will need to bring your own alcohol, make sure you bring enough for however main days you are there, we don't know your tolerance you make the call on how much you bring.

### Tweaker Tear down

The morning of the burn everyone who stays up all night from the night before tears down camp. You can also go to sleep and wake up early to help but some people prefer to stay up all night. Everyone should help clean up the camp that morning before they start working on breaking their own camp down. This occurs on Saturday morning.

### Dark wad

You need lights on yourself at night so that people can see you in the streets and you don't get in a bike crash or an art car doesn't run your ass over. Lights on the front and back. If you don't, people will call you a dark wad and you'll be yelled at. Glow sticks aren't enough so get some

led lights on amazon. If you have a head lamp on please don't leave it on when talking to someone and shining it in their eyes. That's a light wad

### **Camp bathroom**

This is shared space, please keep it clean. No one wants to do their business in a dirty/trashed environment. You will need a shower token to be able to shower. If you find the bathroom needs to be cleaned/restocked please let the bathroom lead of that day know. You will be given shower tokens when you arrive. Don't invite strangers to use our bathroom if it fills up before a pump out we'll all need to go to the porta potties if our bathroom is full. When you're out and about at night the porto's have a little blue light on each end to help you find them.

### **Grid/generator**

If you have a spot on the grid, please make sure you are not running anything in your trailer/tent 24/7. Please only have it running while you are in there and need power. If you are not in the trailer someone may unplug you and take your cord if it continues.

### **Water/hydration**

Make sure you bring at least 1.5 gallons of water for each day that you will be on the playa. In addition, it's also a good idea to have a pedialyte for the rough mornings- at least half a pedialyte for each day you're out there. Make sure you're drinking lots of water and getting lots of electrolytes, it is hot and you will get dehydrated. PISS CLEAR

### **Moop**

If you see it, pick it up. Don't be a dirt bag:) you are responsible for packing out your own trash and also one bag of camp trash. Make sure to take this into consideration when packing. If you smoke, make sure you are disposing of your butt correctly, do not throw them on to the playa (altoids container works great for butts).

### **Location**

Nipple crime is located at 800 & D this year. It's always important to know landmarks around our camp that are tall and you can see from a distance (pick landmarks that aren't mobile). This can help you find your way back to camp at night while you're fucked up. If you need a porta potty away from camp, you can look for little blue lights.

### **Illegal Substances / Police-**

At nipple crime we do not care what you decide to do when you party but there are a few major things to remember

- always do them in private and not in the open
- there are people always watching and sometimes it can be the cops
- pace yourself, it is a long event
- understand navigation and how that relates to getting back to nipple crime before going to wild
- marijuana is illegal at burning man
- be careful of smell/ smoke

- try not to carry illegal stuff with you while away from camp
- if you do be super careful
- do not do them in the open
- go to a porta potty/trailer/yurt/another dimension

### **UNDER COVER COPS ARE A THING AT BURNING MAN**

- don't bring people you or your friends do not know back to your tent or trailer.
- If something is off about a person typically your instinct is correct
- In past experiences the undercover cops will be way too quick to ask for drugs or where they can find drugs
