

## **Bluegrass United Participant Code of Conduct**

Bluegrass United is a community that supports Central Kentucky high school home schooled students. Our mission is:

1. To honor the Lord our God
2. To promote the interests of all members
3. To provide academics, athletics, performing arts, and social opportunities homeschooled youth of high school age
4. To provide support and fellowship among its own members for the benefit, enjoyment, instruction, and well-being of its members
5. To provide an overall environment where all members honor the Christian-Judeo values to which this group ascribes

With this in mind, students and parent members agree to the following expectations.

- Members will conduct themselves, in speech and in actions, in such a way to bring honor to God and to their families.
- Members will demonstrate respect to everyone: students, staff, parents and others in authority.
- Members will guard their tongue and not use coarse or offensive language, curse or misuse God's name.
- Participants agree to remain on the event property unless given permission by an adult leader or chaperone. Once students leave the event property, they are ineligible to return.
- Participants will remain in the designated facility areas at all times during events.
- Participants must show respect for event properties and equipment at all times.
- Participants will promptly and cheerfully obey any directions given by leaders, chaperones, or other adults assuming responsibility for BU events
- Participants will not damage or be careless with property.
- Participants will pick up after themselves.
- Participants may not participate in any illegal, immoral, or unhealthy activity of any kind while at BU classes, games, tournaments, or events.
- Participants agree to avoid consumption of alcoholic beverages, illicit drugs, or use of tobacco products including vaping.
- Participants will not be in possession of any weapons or explosives while in attendance at BU events.
- Participants agree to abide by the BU Dress Code.
- Members agree that violation of this Code of Conduct and/or other rules specified by BU teachers, coaches, directors, managers, or an adult in charge may result in the following:
  - a. Removal from BU activities and events
  - b. Temporary dismissal (sent home for the day)
  - c. Being sent home for the remainder of the semester without refund.
  - d. Paying the costs or repairs in the event of damage/destruction of property.
  - e. Ineligibility to participate in future BU programs.
- Additional program or event guidelines may apply. Members are expected to adhere to all expectations of BU events and programs.
