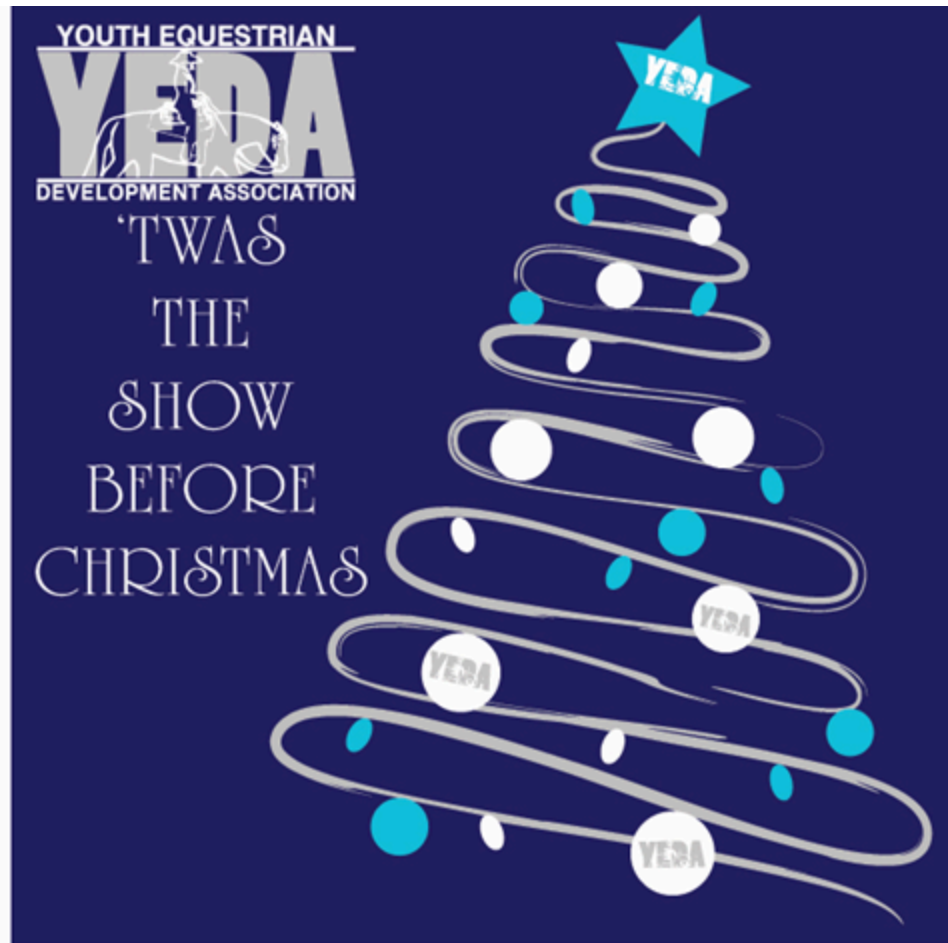

Electric Policy!

YEDA will adhere to a very strict policy for the rest of YEDA show season **"No one can plug anything into any facility outlet"**. If a team or individual needs to plug in a truck, trailer or camper a hookup fee will be charged, which **must be paid ahead of time in the YEDA office, once paid a permit will be given as proof of purchase**. Hook up fees vary depending on location and charged per night. Generators are prohibited in and near the arena. You are welcome to bring a camper or horse trailer and park it in the camping area to house your generator and the items you plan to run off your generator. There will be a \$100 fine for generators outside designated areas or for plugging items in not in the camping area.

Many teams enjoy planning and bringing their team food to the shows and you can still do this but with a camper or trailer hook up fee and keep all your feasts appliances, crock pots, and food inside. We hope you will understand that we are not trying to be difficult but we must be respectful of the facilities that we are using and continue to show there for many years. Please pass this information along to your teams. We are looking forward to having great shows that are fun and educational for all our exhibitors.

1. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first two large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
2. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
3. Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
4. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
5. Beginning on the right lead, run a large fast circle to the right, change leads at the center of the arena, run large fast circle to the left, and change leads at the center of the arena. (Figure 8)
6. Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
7. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
8. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Backup to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

Horse Descriptions

1. **Dawg** - (Puthoff) **Height Limit 5'9"** Ball or no ball spur, small horse moderate contact, set up for leads - especially right use leg in corners or circles.
2. **Zip** - (Puthoff) Dull spur - lazy - moderate contact, good jogger, has a rough canter.
3. **Travis** - (Puthoff) **Height Limit 5'9" Weight Limit #160** - No or Dull Spur, moderate contact, light leg, use leg on circles, knows lead changes.
4. **Jessie** (Puthoff) - Ball or dull rowel spurs. Contact on reins. No lead change, gets a little dancy at start of pattern. Keep moving.
5. **Val**- (Champion Hill) Arab. **Height Limit 5'9" Weight Limit #160** Rides in Romel. Can bridle up. Voice command. Very kind lesson type, Not good backer. Has a simple lead change.
6. **Hope**- (Champion Hill) DO NOT over cinch. Drops inside shoulder. Set up for leads. NO spurs.
7. **Mister**- (Champion Hill) DO NOT over cinch. Big mover. Strong horse. SEt up for leads. Division appropriate spurs.
8. **Capri** - (Champion Hill) Spur stop broke. Start day no spurs. Set up, will get quick if given the opportunity. Squeeze to slow.
9. **Liz** - (Champion Hill) - Super nice consistent reiner. No big stops, Spins soft, works off leg. Quiet hands
10. **Champion Ruby** - Spur stop, keep her motivated in the jog, can be lazy, crop option, division appropriate spurs. Set up for leads.
11. **Hungry** (Champion Hill)- Ranch/Reiner. Easy horse. Set up for lead - go to legs/voice. Strong leg to spin.
12. **Junior** (EQD) Bay QH Gelding - Keep collected and will give a good ride. Firm leg. Spurs ok.
13. **Sugar** (EQD)Buckskin QH Mare - Use soft holding contact on her mouth. Can slow her bouncy trot by softening mouth. Set up for leads. Will go with or without spurs.
14. **Nala** (EQD)- Solid paint mare (EQD)- Really nice horse. She needs a little pushing at times so crop would be ok. She is spur broke. Needs set up for transitions. Will cut corners if the rider allows.
15. **Melody** (EQD) Red Dun QH mare. Needs ridden with contact but not a lot of bit pressure.Support with leg for lope. Spurs needed for lope.
16. **Stan** (EQD) Sorrel POA Gelding (EQD)- Can get quick, hold with quiet rein. Set up for leads. May need spurs later day.
17. **JayR** (EQD) Bay QH Gelding (EQD)- Good draw but can be lazy. Use lots of leg. Spurs ok.
18. **Zee** (EQD) Black QH Gelding (EQD)- 2 handed option. Will be better 2 handed for patterns. Will bridle up if asked correctly. Need to maintain soft mouth contact. Soft legs, set up for right lead. BIG mover but safe. Leg release to stop and slow down.
19. **Snips** (KCPH) - Top level horse, the more legs you use the better the ride, Has a spur stop, flying lead change. Has nice extensions to each gear. Shush to him to speed up, hmm and squeeze legs to slow down.
20. **Monty** (KCPH) - Light hold on his face for best ride. Voice commands is best however has a bit of a spur stop, hold to back. Keep outside leg on him to keep loping on correct lead otherwise will swap.
21. **Dusty** (KCPH) - Very light face contact, the more you quietly use your legs the better.Light outside leg for loping otherwise will lope sideways. Spur stop.
22. **Scooter** (Double H) - 14.2 hands **Height/Weight Limit 5'5" & 135#**, Buckskin Gelding. Will frame up at walk and jog but not at lope. Keep soft and light. Light rein contact. Set up for right lead. Will anticipate cues. Neck rein. Ask Soft. Ball spur ok.
23. **Skinny** (Double H) 15.2 hands - **weight limit #150** Black mare, can get forward if you let her. Light leg and rein contact. Like verbal cues. One or two hands. One is better for patterns. Ball spur ok.

24. **Vegas** (Double H) 16 hands - **Weight Limit #160** Bay gelding. High headed, set up for right lead. Keep soft and light. Ball spur. Two hands. Will pattern only 90 pivot.
25. **Raisin** (Hancock) (Hancock) Bay Quarter Horse Gelding. Good, easy draw. Ride with some contact. Squeeze to slow him down. Will neck rein, but use legs to help guide him around. Can be lazy when asked to trot. Walk trot only. Can use crop if having lazy day.
26. **Remi** (Hancock) Sorrel Quarter Horse Mare. Good draw. Ride with light contact. Has a leg release stop. Set up for leads. Great pattern horse. To slow down release your legs off of her, but not so much she will stop. Do not squeeze to slow her down, it will make her go faster. Use level appropriate spurs but do not overuse spur.
27. **Chester** (Hancock) Chestnut Quarter Horse Gelding. Good draw. Stay relaxed on him. Can ride with light contact. Easy draw and great pattern horse. Squeeze to slow down and kiss to lope off. Talk to him when you stop and break down to trot or walk. Ball spurs preferred but can use rowel.
28. **Milo** (Hancock) Reiner, Hold during run downs in reining. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Leg release stop. Honest; great draw.
29. **Gator** (Hancock) Palomino QH, Reiner type. Leg release stop. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Light contact with bit. Honest, great draw.
30. **Izzy** (Hancock) ranch type let her have a little forward do not over bridle has lead change, may need ball spurs as the day unfolds. Please check with steward throughout the day.
31. **Misty** (Hancock) - 2 handed option for both reining and horsemanship. Horsemanship- light rein contact, level-appropriate spurs allowed. Can jog and lope slow will be higher headed. Reining- rowels allowed, ride with light contact, help her in spins but don't drag her around. Good leaded.
32. **Duncan** (Cornerhouse) - **Height/Weight Limit 5'5" & 135#**, Cluck to jog, can have contact, good draw, can get grumpy. No Spurs
33. **Nick** (Cornerhouse) - Cluck to jog, kiss to lope. Good draw easy going No Spurs
34. **Charlie** - (Mark Smith) APHA Gelding. Soft contact do not over bridle!!! Spur stop & spur slow down, use voice commands, division appropriate spurs, crop option for walk jog, when riding patterns ride with light contact, do not force into maneuvers use your legs and voice. Only paddock steward may adjust tack!!!!
35. **Ginny** - (Mark Smith) APHA mare. division appropriate spurs, soft contact, set up for leads, use your voice commands! Medium to light contact. Leg release stop. Neck rein.
36. **Blue:** (Marcia)Sorrel/White Paint Mare Easy ride. Keep in the bridle and will give a good ride. Quiet Firm leg. Spurs ok.
37. **Jess**-(Marcia) Does all maneuvers very well. Rides with light bit contact. Can get quick in the run down to stops. Rider can wear spurs
38. **Grinder**-(Marcia) Does all maneuvers well. Needs to be pushed into the bridle and supported to stops. Light contact on bit and guided with riders legs.
39. **Foxy**- Findlay (Saturday) Light contact. Light leg. Legs off to stop. Ball Spur option.
40. **Gretel** – Findlay (Saturday) Light contact. Light leg. Set up for left lead. Legs off to stop. Spur Option
41. **Hansel**- Findlay (Saturday) Can get lazy. Light contact. Light leg. Ride forward. Legs off to stop. Spur Option.
42. **Julio**- Findlay (Saturday) Goes in bridle, light contact, light leg. Legs off to stop. Spur Option

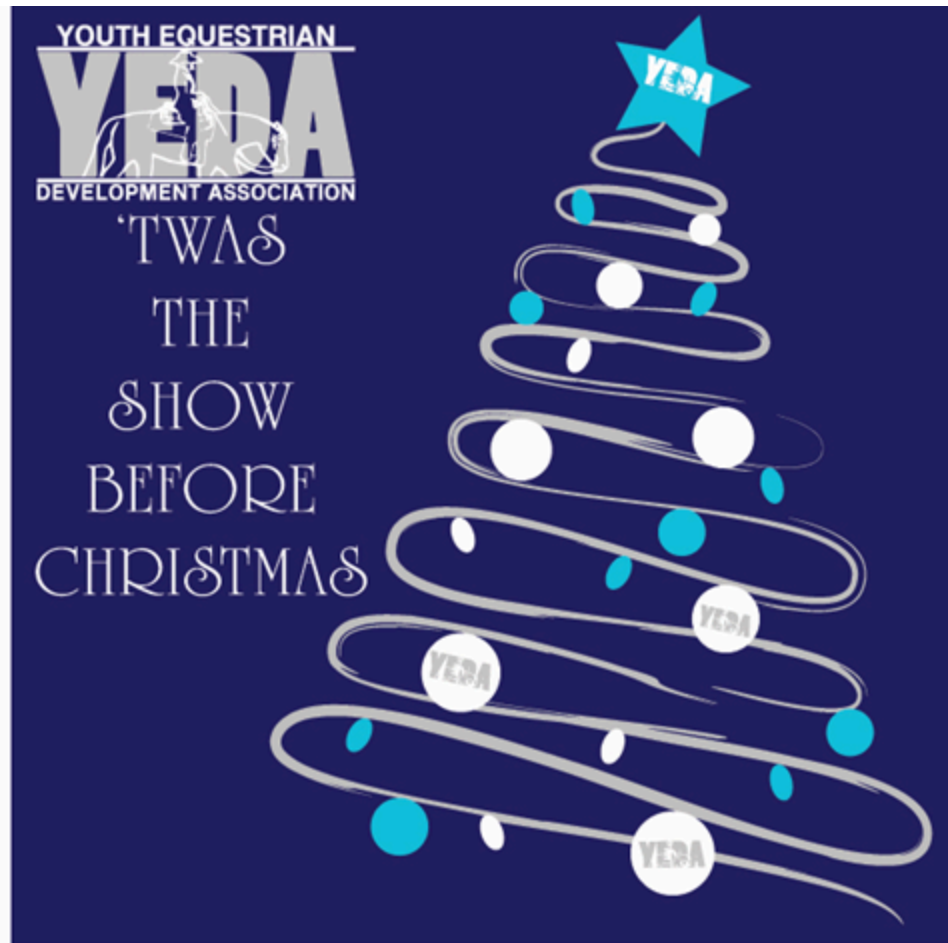

YEDA will adhere to a very strict policy for the rest of YEDA show season **"No one can plug anything into any facility outlet"**. If a team or individual needs to plug in a truck, trailer or camper a hookup fee will be charged, which **must be paid ahead of time in the YEDA office, once paid a permit will be given as proof of purchase**. Hook up fees vary depending on location and charged per night. Generators are prohibited in and near the arena. You are welcome to bring a camper or horse trailer and park it in the camping area to house your generator and the items you plan to run off your generator. There will be a \$100 fine for generators outside designated areas or for plugging items in not in the camping area.

Many teams enjoy planning and bringing their team food to the shows and you can still do this but with a camper or trailer hook up fee and keep all your feasts appliances, crock pots, and food inside. We hope you will understand that we are not trying to be difficult but we must be respectful of the facilities that we are using and continue to show there for many years. 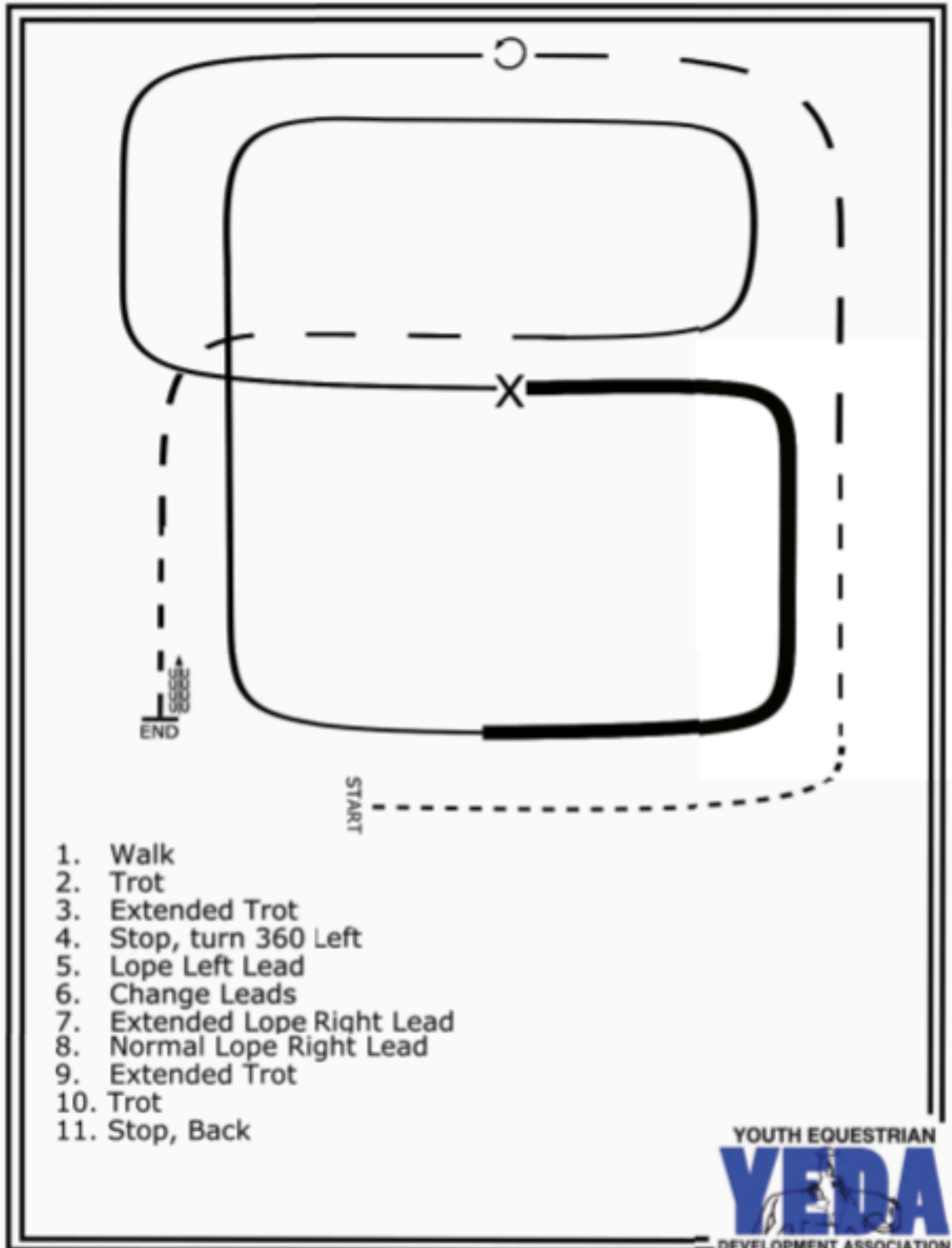

NRHA Pattern 2



Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
2. Complete three circles to the left: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
3. Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
4. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
5. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Backup to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (threemeters). Hesitate.
6. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
7. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.

Horse Descriptions

1. **Dawg** - (Puthoff) **Height Limit 5'9"** Ball or no ball spur, small horse moderate contact, set up for leads - especially right use leg in corners or circles. 2 hand option for for ranch riding and reining.
2. **Zip** - (Puthoff) Dull spur - lazy - moderate contact, good jogger, has a rough canter.
3. **Travis** - (Puthoff) **Height Limit 5'9"** **Weight Limit #160** - No or Dull Spur, moderate contact, light leg, use leg on circles, knows lead changes.
4. **Jessie** (Puthoff) - Ball or dull rowel spurs. Contact on reins. No lead change, gets a little dancy at start of pattern. Keep moving.
5. **Val**- (Champion Hill) Arab. **Height Limit 5'5"** **Weight Limit #135** Rides in Romel. Can bridle up. Voice command. Very kind lesson type, Not good backer. Has a simple lead change.
6. **Hope**- (Champion Hill) DO NOT over cinch. Drops inside shoulder. Set up for leads. NO spurs.
7. **Mister**- (Champion Hill) DO NOT over cinch. Big mover. Strong horse. SEt up for leads. Division appropriate spurs.
8. **Capri** - (Champion Hill) Spur stop broke. Start day no spurs. Set up, will get quick if given the opportunity. Squeeze to slow.
9. **Liz** - (Champion Hill) - Super nice consistent reiner. No big stops, Spins soft, works off leg. Quiet hands.
10. **Champion Ruby** - Spur stop, keep her motivated in the jog, can be lazy, crop option, division appropriate spurs. Set up for leads.
11. **Hungry** (Champion Hill)- Ranch/Reiner. Easy horse. Set up for lead - go to legs/voice. Strong leg to spin.
12. **Junior** (EQD) Bay QH Gelding - Keep collected and will give a good ride. Firm leg. Spurs ok.
13. **Sugar** (EQD)Buckskin QH Mare - Use soft holding contact on her mouth. Can slow her bouncy trot by softening mouth. Set up for leads. Will go with or without spurs.
14. **Nala** (EQD)- Solid paint mare (EQD)- Really nice horse. She needs a little pushing at times so crop would be ok. She is spur broke. Needs set up for transitions. Will cut corners if the rider allows.
15. **Darlene** (EQD) - Black/White Paint Mare (EQD)- Set up for right lead. Soft hand. Spur stops, collect with leg. Ball Spurs ok.
16. **Stan** (EQD) Sorrel POA Gelding (EQD)- Can get quick, hold with quiet rein. Set up for leads. May need spurs later day.
17. **JayR** (EQD) Bay QH Gelding (EQD)- Good draw but can be lazy. Use lots of leg. Spurs ok.
18. **Zee** (EQD) Black QH Gelding (EQD)- 2 handed option. Will be better 2 handed for patterns. Will bridle up if asked correctly. Need to maintain soft mouth contact. Soft legs, set up for right lead. BIG mover but safe. Leg release to stop and slow down. Ball spur ok
19. **Snips** (KCPH) - Top level horse, the more legs you use the better the ride, Has a spur stop, flying lead change. Has nice extensions to each gear. Shush to him to speed up, hmm and squeeze legs to slow down.
20. **Monty** (KCPH) - Light hold on his face for best ride. Voice commands is best however has a bit of a spur stop, hold to back. Keep outside leg on him to keep loping on correct lead otherwise will swap. Two hand option, especially for patterns neck rain steering isn't perfect. No spurs
21. **Dusty** (KCPH) - Very light face contact, the more you quietly use your legs the better.Light outside leg for loping otherwise will lope sideways. Spur stop.
22. **Bella** (Bayhill) - Reiner. Will get hot. Hold in the bridle. Loosen reins for spins.
23. **Felix** (Bayhill) - Chestnut gelding. Keep in the bridle. Use rowel spur first YEDA show.
24. **Ozzy** (Bayhill) - Reiner, Palomino gelding. Laxy. Use rowel spurs. Show be show in reining with loose rein.
25. **Emitt** (Bayhill) - Sorrel gelding. Hold in the bridle. Use leg to turn around. Dull in his belly, use rowell spur if allowed or crop for lower division.
26. **Scooter** (Double H) - 14.2 hands **Height/Weight Limit 5'5"** **& 135#**, Buckskin Gelding. Will frame up at walk and jog but not at lope. Keep soft and light. Light rein contact. Set up for right lead. Will anticipate cues. Neck rein. Ask Soft. Check about spurs as the day progresses, possible ball spur option Crop option.

27. **Skinny** (Double H) 15.2 hands - **weight limit #150** Black mare, can get forward if you let her. Light leg and rein contact. Like verbal cues. One or two hands. One is better for patterns. Ball spur ok.
28. **Viva Las Vegas** (Double H) 16 hands - **Weight Limit #160** Bay gelding. High headed, set up for right lead. Keep soft and light. Ball spur. Two hands ONLY. Will pattern only 90 pivot.
29. **Raisin** (Hancock) (Hancock) Bay Quarter Horse Gelding. Good, easy draw. Ride with some contact. Squeeze to slow him down. Will neck rein, but use legs to help guide him around. Can be lazy when asked to trot. Walk trot only. Can use crop if having lazy day.
30. **Remi** (Hancock) Sorrel Quarter Horse Mare. Good draw. Ride with light contact. Has a leg release stop. Set up for leads. Great pattern horse. To slow down release your legs off of her, but not so much she will stop. Do not squeeze to slow her down, it will make her go faster. Use level appropriate spurs but do not overuse spur.
31. **Chester** (Hancock) Chestnut Quarter Horse Gelding. Good draw. Stay relaxed on him. Can ride with light contact. Easy draw and great pattern horse. Squeeze to slow down and kiss to lope off. Talk to him when you stop and break down to trot or walk. Ball spurs preferred but can use rowel.
32. **Milo** (Hancock) Reiner, Hold during run downs in reining. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Leg release stop. Honest; great draw.
33. **Gator** (Hancock) Palomino QH, Reiner type. Leg release stop. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Light contact with bit. Honest, great draw.
34. **Izzy** (Hancock) ranch type let her have a little forward do not over bridle has lead change, may need ball spurs as the day unfolds. Please check with steward throughout the day. Possible ball spur option.
35. **Misty** (Hancock) - 2 handed option for both reining and horsemanship. Horsemanship- light rein contact, level-appropriate spurs allowed. Can jog and lope slow will be higher headed. Reining- rowels allowed, ride with light contact, help her in spins but don't drag her around. Good leaded.
36. **Duncan** (Cornerhouse) - **Height/Weight Limit 5'5" & 135#**, Cluck to jog, can have contact, good draw, can get grumpy. No Spurs
37. **Nick** (Cornerhouse) - Cluck to jog, kiss to lope. Good draw easy going No Spurs
38. **Charlie** - (Mark Smith) APHA Gelding. Soft contact do not over bridle!!! Spur stop & spur slow down, use voice commands, division appropriate spurs, crop option for walk jog, when riding patterns ride with light contact, do not force into maneuvers use your legs and voice. Only paddock steward may adjust tack!!!!
39. **Ginny** - (Mark Smith) APHA mare. division appropriate spurs, soft contact, set up for leads, use your voice commands! Medium to light contact. Leg release stop. Neck rein
40. **Blue:** (Marcia)Sorrel/White Paint Mare Easy ride. Keep in the bridle and will give a good ride. Quiet Firm leg. Spurs ok.
41. **Jess**-(Marcia) Does all maneuvers very well. Rides with light bit contact. Can get quick in the run down to stops. Rider can wear spurs
42. **Grinder**-(Marcia) Does all maneuvers well. Needs to be pushed into the bridle and supported to stops. Light contact on bit and guided with riders legs. Division Appropriate Spurs.
43. **CNPH Ruby** - CNPH (Sunday Only) - Gypsy vanner mare. Best if kept in bridle on the shorter rein. Spurs or crop is fine. Set up for leads. Can get forward towards the gate.
44. **Indy** - CNPH (Sunday Only) Draft Cross - Ride with a lot of leg. Very bouncy but is a gentle giant. Spur or crop is fine. Will frame up. Ride with contact.
45. **Roxie** - CNPH (Sunday Only) Quarter Pony - 14.1 hands Height/Weight Limit 5'5" & 135# - Will get forward in patterns if not kept in frame. Spurs or crop is fine. Use legs and hands together and she will stay lifted, will pull to stop.
46. **Otis**- Findlay (Sunday) Light contact. Light leg. Legs off to stop. Spur option.
47. **Reno**- Findlay (Sunday) Can get lazy. Ride forward. Legs off to stop. Flying change. Spur option.
48. **Swiss Miss**- Findlay (Sunday) Can get lazy. Ride forward. Legs off to stop. Spur option
49. **Tom**- Findlay (Sunday) Bouncy draw! Can get lazy, ride forward. Will kick if too close to other horses. Legs off to stop. Spur Option

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
