**Course Title:** Leadership Education I-IV

**Course Name:** Marine Corps Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps (MCJROTC)

**Purpose.** The MCJROTC program is designed to instill in high school students the values of citizenship, service to the United States, personal responsibility, and a sense of accomplishment. It prepares high school students for responsible leadership roles while making them aware of their rights, obligations, and privileges as American citizens.

### **Course Objectives:**

- Develop leadership, build character, and create informed and responsible citizens.
- Develop young adults who are physically, mentally, and morally fit.
- Develop civic-minded young adults prepared for both higher education and public service.
- Instill discipline, respect, and responsibility through military-related subjects and activities.

**Special Information.** This program consists of up to four levels of instruction. Students are required to enroll in this course for an entire year; MCJROTC is available on a semester basis. Upon successful course completion, students will receive two credits per year.
