- 2. In Minecraft, go to Play, then Import.

- 3. Enter the world.
- 4. Talk to the NPC and get the Book and Quill and Camera.
- 5. Read the directions on the board.
- 6. Make your Creation.
- 7. Take a picture of your creation.
- 8. Put your picture in your book.
- 9. Describe your creation and the materials you used to make it.
- 10. Export the book to a PDF.
- 11. Turn it in to Google Classroom or to your teacher.

**Conclusion:** Share your creation with your classmates and compare materials and products. What other scenes did your classmates make?
