Student Assessments

In addition to district and classroom specific assessments, the School District of Slinger administers standardized [assessments](#) annually to students in all grade levels. The State of Wisconsin requires 4th, 8th, 9th, 10th, and 11th grade examinations administered to students enrolled in the district, as well as the assessment requirements under ACT 20 that pertain to grades 4K-3rd.

Parent Communication

The district informs parents and the public about information on any state required assessments, locally determined assessments and additional assessments required by the ESEA (Elementary and Secondary Act). Communication to parents includes: participation requirements, subject matter, purpose, when and where such information is available, assessment time; and the schedule and format for disseminating results.
