External Speaker Process at LUU



In order for LUU to comply with several bits of legislation, we need to have a record of every **external speaker** invited to campus (or to online events) by our Clubs & Societies, Student Leaders, Exec and **LUU staff**.

Work undergone over the past year has meant a tightening up of that process. Headline changes mean that;

Staff must submit an External Speaker application 21 working days before a proposed event. That means staff at LUU have time to come together, research and put together a risk assessment with the Principal Organiser if required.
