

Ron Harman Music Scholarship

Background

A North Clarion High School valedictorian and a Penn State University graduate, Ron Harman has been a longtime employee of the Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum and Historic RCA Studio B in Nashville, Tennessee. A country music historian and journalist, Ron is also a longtime member of organizations such as the Country Music Association (CMA) and the Academy of Country Music (ACM).

Overview

Ron Harman would like to provide a \$1,000 scholarship to a member of the North Clarion High School graduating class who has a background and interest in music.

Process

1. Applicants should submit:
 - A. Copy of letter of acceptance to a two-year or four-year accredited college or university. *Note: Although pursuit of a music degree will be given consideration, it is not a requirement.*
 - B. Copy of transcript and current report card.
 - C. One-page essay describing:
 - Music-related interests, background, and skills.
 - Music-related participation and achievements related to school, church, or civic programs and activities.
 - Career aspirations (*though not restricted to music*) and any future music-related plans or goals.
2. A scholarship committee will screen applicants and choose the recipient.
3. The recipient of this scholarship will be announced at the Awards Assembly in May.
