- Outgoing Chair Malliga Och opening statements
 - Highlighted the decisions by IPSA to not fund the pre-conference workshop.
 - Suggested start planning for mid-cycle RC 19 sponsored event and apply for IPSA funds.
 - Suggested start reaching out to local scholars at 2025 host country (South Korea) to plan pre-conference.
- Incoming Chair Pedro dos Santos comments
 - The IPSA 2023 pre-conference was organized with RC 07 and happened successfully. The theme was “Global South Gender Claims and Disputes: Trajectories, Threats and Achievements,” and it featured five scholars from Brazil, Argentina, United States, India, and Slovenia. The event was attended by 20-30 participants and it was very well received.

 - Asked about broad suggestions for larger online engagement.
- Possible Mid-Cycle Events:
 - Organize something in conjunction to the IPSA sponsored events that will take place next year in April and September.
 - Suggested topic: Speaking Out-The Political Impact of #MeToo.
