Scanning Designation Changing

Saturday, October 25 - Sunday, November 2

- As of October 1, 2025, our scanning designation is changing from daily to random.
- We will be requesting random scanning for students as they enter the building at least two days a week.
- Scanning days will depend upon availability of School Safety Agents and scanning resources.

IEP Annual Review Scheduling

- At every IEP meeting, participants must include the Special Education teacher along with a General Education teacher that teaches the students, along with a District Representative.
- IEP meetings should be scheduled during the Special Education teacher's "Admin" period since it is their professional assignment.
- General Education teachers participate during their prep period and are compensated with a coverage payment.
- In the event that the above referenced situation is not possible, the Special Education teacher should speak to the AP's ISS to determine a solution.
- This year due to strategic programming of common planning time, general education teachers are advised not to use this time for IEP meetings. They will not be compensated for loss of an "admin" period.
