Background

The NRC has long-supported campus recycling, first hosting caucuses of campus program managers in 1992, then supporting a technical council in 1995. As it reorganized, the NRC re-established the [Campus Council](#) in 2013 to meet the need for stronger linkages between higher ed and the SMM industry.

The Campus Council is managed by Jack DeBell, who previously served on the NRC Board, helped advance this early collegiate work, and recently retired from the University of Colorado. He receives adhoc assistance from the NRC Board. He coordinates the operation and production of the annual NRC Scholarship Endowment.

2025 is slated to be an important transitional year for both the structure and staffing of both the Campus Council and the Murray Fox Scholarship. The combination of a new Executive Director, possible campus location(s) for future Congress(es), and sponsorships, hold exciting opportunities for meeting the Campus Council's mission.
