

Speaking Challenge

After participating in a successful online 30-day Speaking Challenge, we believe that this activity could be beneficial for Hindi University students.

The concept is simple: you record a short monologue on a given topic or prompt. You have the flexibility to improvise a couple of minutes of speech (perhaps after looking up some vocabulary) or prepare precise speaking notes to read from. Feel free to adapt the speaking prompt to your proficiency level as you wish.

When you are ready to record, use [Vocaroo](#), a user-friendly tool, to create your audio file. After recording, share the link to your audio on Discord and optionally include a transcript. This [helpful, short video](#) explains the technology of Vocaroo; it's simple and works great.

The Speaking Challenge offers an excellent opportunity to work on your pronunciation, vocabulary, grammar, and writing skills (if you choose to prepare a text). Additionally, you can enhance your listening skills by reviewing posts from other participants.

The idea is that Hindi University students (at least a few) would listen to a student's recording and provide constructive feedback.

To keep the activity fresh, we plan to create new prompts every month and add them to our collection. You are free to choose any prompt at any time and modify it to suit your preferences and Hindi proficiency level.

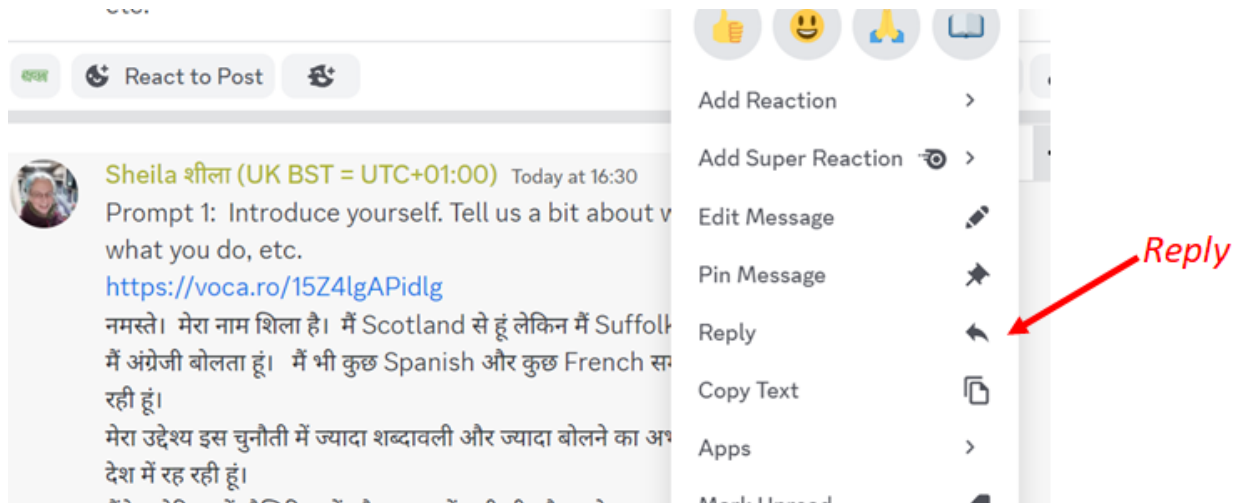

When you wish to COMMENT on a challenge attempt, please make sure you REPLY button on the post you wish to comment on - *do not use the + sign for this*.

That way you ensure your comments stay connected to the audio you are commenting on.

Future readers can then easily read your comment and then jump back to the original post by clicking on the Preview Line at the top.
