Minimum Teacher Qualifications for STAT 1411 - Introduction to Statistics

Applicants are eligible to apply to teach a University of Minnesota Duluth course through College in the Schools if they satisfy the minimum qualifications from group A or B.

Group A

Degree	A minimum of a Secondary Math Education degree or a Secondary Education degree
Classroom Observation	During UMD faculty observation, applicants must demonstrate commitment to current pedagogical methods and standards.

Group B

Degree	Graduate degree in any field
Teaching experience	Two years of experience teaching advanced high school mathematics (above Algebra I and II, Geometry, and PreCalculus).
Professional Development	Show evidence of presenting at conferences or workshops in areas related to developing mathematical knowledge for teaching
Classroom Observation	During UMD faculty observation, applicants must demonstrate commitment to current pedagogical methods and standards.
