

Call for Creative Instructors for 2023 Summer Camp!

What are your 2023 summer plans?

The [Torrance Center for Creativity and Talent Development](#) at the UGA Mary Frances Early College of Education is looking for dynamic instructors to teach innovative classes for our *Creative Explorers Camp*. This program is for students in **grades 8-10** and is an in-person summer camp hosted on the UGA main campus in Athens, Georgia. Our 2023 camp will be composed of four, one-week sessions running **June 12-16 & 26-30** and **July 10-14 & 17-21** from **9am-4pm**. Instructors would be expected to teach for at least two of these weeks but are welcome to apply for all four.

Who are we looking for?

Our campers anticipate high-quality course content they would not typically encounter in their normal school curriculum. Though we expect our instructional staff to independently plan their courses, we will train our instructors on creative strategies in the classroom and assist with acquiring supplies, arranging field trips, and any other needs that will make your course the best possible. Based on these expectations, we are accepting applications from graduate students, experienced teachers, and content area professionals. Instructor pay is \$900 per week.

What classes will be offered?

All innovative course proposals are welcome! Past subjects have included creative writing, sustainable fashion design, augmented & virtual reality, criminal law & mock trial, sports medicine, robotics, journalism, and infectious diseases. We hope to offer creative experiences in a wide range of fields to our campers, so please also consider any topic that will embrace your own expertise – stagecraft, historic preservation, astrophysics, philosophy, film studies – the sky's the limit!
