- **VOLUNTEER-TRAINEE:**
 - Who you are: You are new to volunteering with Community Boathouse or maybe you have been volunteering with Community Boathouse for a while but only once or twice a month each season.
 - What you do: Learning Community Boathouse procedures and helping our Volunteer Paddle Leader's run our various events.
 - Key to next level: Regular attendance and a desire to do more!
- **VOLUNTEER:**
 - Who you are: You have been regularly volunteering with Community Boathouse for at least a full season.
 - What you do: You can help out at an event without much direct involvement from a Volunteer Paddle Leader.
 - Key to next level: 6+ Volunteer days in the last paddling season & Completed Volunteer training.
- **VOLUNTEER-PADDLE LEADER**
 - Who you are: You have probably been regularly volunteering with Community Boathouse for a couple of seasons. You must be at least 21 years old.
 - What you do: You lead events on your own or with other Volunteer Paddle Leaders assisting you and help train other volunteers.
 - May also be a keyholder!
 - May have an @communityboathouse.org email address to help you communicate with other volunteers and the public.
 - Key to next level: N/A
