## **Troop Guide**

These items must be accomplished to the best of the scout's ability, or completed to the satisfaction of the Troop's Scoutmasters in order to receive credit for this troop level position of responsibility. The scout will be expected to complete a "Self-Assessment" form and present it at the Scoutmaster Conference upon the conclusion of this position's term.

Term: 6 months-1 year

## **During his term of office, the Troop Guide must:**

- Attend at least 2/3 of the troop's monthly outings
- Attend at least 2/3's of the Troop meetings
- Attend at least 2/3's of the Troop's monthly PLC meetings
- Introduce new Scouts to the Troop
- Shield new Scouts from harassment by other Scouts and notify the SPL if any such behavior occurs
- Participate in teaching times at troop meetings to instruct the new Scouts in rank
   advancement requirements
- Guide new Scouts in completing the Scout rank requirements
- Serve as Patrol Leader of the New Scout Patrol (and perform all duties of Patrol Leader)
- Participate in new Scout investiture ceremonies
- Provide input to the Scoutmaster on permanent patrol assignments for new Scouts
- Enthusiastically wear the Scout uniform correctly

- Live by the Scout Oath and Law
- Show Scout spirit
- Lead by setting a good example for other Scouts
- Effectively transition responsibilities of the position to incoming Troop Guides
- Complete other duties as assigned by the Senior Patrol Leader
- Be certified by the Scoutmaster that you have adequately completed the duties and requirements of this position.

## Qualifications for the position of Troop Guide are:

- Age \_\_ minimum
- Must be 1<sup>st</sup> Class Rank or higher
- Must have been a member of the Troop for a minimum of 1 year
- Must have successfully completed Troop Leadership Training
- Must have actively participated in long and short term camping with Troop 148
- Preference in appointment to this position is given to those Scouts that have completed Grey
   Wolf.
