### **★** ENTERING THE DRIVE-THRU OPEN HOUSE

• Please enter where you normally enter and proceed in the direction you would for the car line.

- Families are encouraged to decorate their car to showcase their HSC spirit! You can decorate as little or as much as you want, and the theme can be anything!

### ★ LOST & FOUND

- Our Lost & Found will be displayed in plain sight so you don't have to get out of the car to look for student items.
- o If you need to take a closer look at an item please let a staff member know and they will hold it up for you.
- We will have staff members with PPE on to help grab items and deliver to your car.
- Due to the circumstances, we will keep any remaining items over the summer and families will have a chance to look through items in the Fall when we return.

### **★** PROJECT PICK-UP

- Please pull around to the front entrance of the building. We will have staff members posted throughout helping direct families where to go.
- We will have student projects organized by family last name.
- Student projects will be collected from all classes and placed inside a paper bag. Teachers and staff members will be wearing both gloves and masks while assembling paper bags to ensure the safety of our students.
- If students have medication they will be placed inside bags along with their projects.

- We will email you the photo as soon as we have them available.
