There are also the largest and smallest dolphins in the sea. The largest dolphin is called an orca; they are black and white and their dorsal fin can get up to 6 feet tall. The smallest dolphin is a Maui dolphin. They are just over 5 feet in length. The rarest dolphin is Hector's dolphin. Hector's dolphins are the rarest

marine dolphin in the world. They have distinct black facial markings, short stocky bodies, and a dorsal fin shaped like a Mickey Mouse ear.

A dolphin has two stomachs; the first stomach is used for storage, and the second one is where they digest their food. This helps the dolphins carry around a whole lot of food. This sea mammal eats approximately 33 pounds of fish per day.

# The Best Rivalry in the NFL



The Cleveland Browns and Pittsburgh Steelers have been rivals since October 7, 1950.

The Browns have three players on the top 100 greatest players in the NFL today; those are Denzel Ward, Wyatt Teller, and Joel Bitonio. With the Steeler only having one T.J. Watt is in the greatest players in the NFL today. The Browns and the Steelers have played in the playoffs three different times other the years.

The Steelers have a record of 2-1 over the Browns inside of the playoffs. The three years are January first, 1995, January 5th, 2003, and January 10th, 2021. The playoffs that they played in were different rounds of the AFC wild card two times. The AFC divisional round was held in 1995.

The Browns and the Steelers have the best team rivalries in the NFL.

## **Giants of the Jungle**

Elephants live generally in Africa and Asia. There are many types of elephants in Africa such as the African Bush Elephant and the African Forest Elephant.

The elephant population has declined 62% over the last decade with 24,000 elephants poached this year alone. The elephant species that has been at threat the most is the African elephant due to illegal ivory trade. The Asian elephant's biggest threat is habitat loss due to humans taking their habitat away. Elephants are distinctly the largest land living mammals on earth.

They have massive bodies, long ears, and long trunks. They use their trunks to pick up objects, trumpet warnings, greet other elephants, or suck up water for drinking and bathing. Both male and female elephants grow tusks. There is generally one tusk that is smaller than the other that is due to the wear and tear that they put on it. During times of drought they use their tusks to dig holes to find water underground.

The African forest elephant is smaller than the African savanna elephant. Their ears are more oval shaped and their tusks are straighter and point downward. They also have all different sizes of tusks. They also have a much slower reproduction rate compared to the



African savanna elephant. Due to this, they are not able to bounce back from a population decline as quickly. They live in groups called families with up to 20 individuals. They eat leaves, grasses, seeds, fruits, and tree bark. To supplement their diets, they gather at mineral rich watering holes and mineral

licks found throughout the forest. They live to be about 60 to 70 years old. Their gestation period is about 22 to 24 months, and they weigh 3 to 6.6 tons. They are about 10 ft tall and 3 to 10 ft in length.

Another type of elephant is the Indian Elephant. They spend about 19 hours of their day eating. They can produce about 220 pounds of dung per day while wandering a span of 125 miles. They feed on grasses, but mainly large amounts of tree bark, roots, leaves, and sometimes amounts of small stems. Crops such as bananas, rice, and sugarcane are some of the many foods that are favored. Since they need to drink at least once a day they stay close to fresh water. The skin on an elephant is like leather. Elephants are giant and very intelligent animals.

Jalen Ramsey is a cornerback and is going to play for the Miami Dolphins for the 2023-24 NFL season. Ramsey most recently played for the Los Angeles Rams, who went 5-12 for the 2022-23 NFL season. He would later be drafted as fifth overall, which would put him on the Jacksonville Jaguars.

Ramsey's story begins in Smyrna, Tennessee where he was born and raised. For his freshmen year, he attended Ensworth High School, then transferring to Brentwood Academy to complete his three other years of high school. Football was not the only sport Ramsey participated in. He also participated in track and field.

Ramsey would be identified as a five-star athlete, which would get him attention from some big name colleges, such as Florida State University (FSU), as well as The University of Southern California (USC). At first, he committed to USC, but later decided to commit to Florida State. In college, Ramsey was a two-sport athlete. In track and field, he was a three time All-ACC honoree. Ramsey placed third at both the indoor and outdoor ACC Track and Field Championships. In 2014, his best long jump was an astonishing 25 feet, which translates to about eight meters! In his senior track and field season at Florida State, he won the ACC Long Jump Championship.

Ramsey is a very talented athlete, not only at football, but also at track and field.

Lee won against Arizona State's Brandon Coutney. In his senior year of college, Lee lost his Ncaa semifinals match to Matt Romos with only a couple seconds left. Matt Romos gator roled Lee and pinned him. Spencer Lee later medically forfeited the rest of the tournament. Lee took 6th his senior year at the NCAA tournament.

Spencer Lee came out and said that, "He was not hurt and there was no excuse he got out wrestling and that is how he lost."

### The Tallest mammal in the world

Giraffes are the tallest land mammal in existence. They are mainly found in the dry savannas of Africa in the open plains. They are known for their long necks and different spot colors. Their necks can stretch up to about 7 feet in length. An adult male giraffe can grow around 5.5 m, that's taller than three adult humans, and an adult female can get up to 4.5m tall. A giraffe's height is helpful for looking out for predators and eating food from high trees. Also their long legs allow them to run up to 35 miles an hour over short distances.

Their favorite food is acacia trees, but they also eat mimosa and wild apricot trees. Giraffe's spend most of their time eating. They can eat up to 45 kg of leaves and twigs a day. Giraffes get most of their water from their food, though in the dry season they drink at least every three days.

Their numbers are declining fast due to habitat loss. It dropped down to 40% in Africa. Giraffe's were recently added to the IUCN's Endangered Species list.

The earliest known giraffe was called a Palaeotragus. It lived about 20 million years ago. It lived in eastern Africa during the Pleistocene. Giraffe's were once called a camel-leopard. Romans believed it was a combination of a camel and a leopard hence the name camel-leopard.

A study that took place in 2007 said due to genetics, there should be about six different species of giraffes. The West African, Rothschild's, Reticulated, Masai, Angolan, and South African Giraffe are the six species that they found.

The West African giraffe stands to about 19 feet, and they weigh up to about 2,800 pounds. The males have thicker horns than the females do.



The Rothschild giraffes are mainly located in Eastern Uganda and western Kenya. They rarely sleep, but if they do they sleep for only 30 minutes out of the entire 24 hour day. Reticulated giraffes are about 17 feet. They are able to run about 35 mph. These types of giraffes only drink water every 2 - 3 days. Masai giraffes came from Kenya. They eat 16 - 20 hours a day and rarely sleep. They only sleep 5 - 30 minutes a day. The Angolan giraffes are all throughout Angola and Zambia. They have around 2 - 4 horns instead of just 2 like other giraffes. South African giraffes usually live in savannas and woodlands. They eat leaves, flowers, fruit, and different types of woody plants. Giraffes are very tall and clever animals.
