## General Information and Highlighted Rules

### Welcome!

Thank you for registering for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Shaver Shiver: It is my goal to provide an event format that you will enjoy. You can add to the enjoyment factor of the atmosphere as well! Please be considerate of PDGA rules and of your fellow competitors. This means no alcohol consumption during the event, and please keep your language in check the best you can. There are many junior players in the field that don't need to hear such language and many adults who do not wish to hear it either.

**Tournament Central & Bathrooms:** Tournament Central will be near hole one and restrooms in the main building will be available for some of the day (wipe your feet before you enter building please). Outside bathrooms will be available at ball fields all day.

**Lunch:** There are several lunch options within a few minutes' drive of the event. I will be posting the second-round hole assignments on the PDGA results page so you know where to go for round 2. **Due the time difference in playing each course, the second round for each pool may be at different times. I will cover this at player meeting, but players that travel together and playing in different pools will need to plan lunch understanding they will not be on lunch break together.**

**PDGA Live Scoring:** The person listed at the top of the hole grouping is responsible for the backup scoring. UDisc, Paper or a second scorekeeper on PDGA live scoring are all acceptable as a backup method. The second person listed from the top is responsible to keep PDGA Live scoring. I don't really care who keeps the live scoring, but if there is a dispute over who does it, go with #2. To login to live scoring, go to PDGA.com/score and enter the passcode (**Shiver23**) If you have more questions, refer to live scoring FAQ on the PDGA.com site.

**Pool Zero:** MPO, FPO, MP40, MA1, MA40, MA2

7:20-8:20 AM: Check in and pick up your player pack. If you do not check in with me by 8:20 AM, you may lose your spot.  
**Don't be late!**

8:25 AM: Quick Player Meeting

8:50 AM: First round tee times shotgun start. **Pool Sub plays Original Course. Pool Zero Plays Championship Course.**

12:00-1:00 PM (Approximate): 2<sup>nd</sup> round tee times will begin. (I will send exact 2<sup>nd</sup> round tee time start out to email list for event and post on the Upstate Disc Golf Facebook Page. It will be about an hour after all 1<sup>st</sup> round scores have been submitted and have updated online.) **FYI, both pools may not restart at the exact same time due to the time it takes to finish each course. Pool Zero plays Original Course. Pool Sub Plays Championship Course.**

4:30 PM (Approximate): Awards and payouts will occur when all division participants have completed their rounds.

## **OB and Course Rules**

There are 2 layouts in play for each course. See scorecards that are sent with the player email or in picture section of the tourney page in Disc Golf Sene.

Make sure you are familiar with the PDGA Competition Manual and Official Rules of Disc Golf. All PDGA rules shall be observed.

Shaver Original: (Cash CTP Holes: 1, 8, 9, 18)

HOLE 1: Be aware of players standing at hole 2's tee box before your throw.

HOLE 2: Be aware of people teeing off from hole 1.

There are no designated mando or OB on the Original course. Any water encountered is considered casual relief.

Shaver Championship: (Cash CTP Hole: 17)

HOLE 5 OB: Disc surrounded by water in creek.

HOLE 7 OB: Flagged edges of creek mark OB. Drives that go OB proceed to marked drop zone with normal OB penalty (PDGA exception granted). After initial drive observe normal PDGA rules for OB.

HOLE 8 OB: Surrounded by water and beyond is OB for creek that runs between 8 and 10's fairway.

HOLE 9 OB: Surrounded by water in creek is OB. Player can choose to throw from marked drop zone (orange tee) or follow normal OB rules for any disc that goes OB.

HOLE 10 OB: Surrounded by water in creek is OB. Any disc beyond the water on the creek to the right of the fairway and hole is OB.

HOLE 13: Mando to the right of the tree marked with the yellow sign with black arrow. Any disc that misses mando takes 1 stroke penalty and throws from designated drop zone in the fairway.

HOLE 14 OB: Surrounded by water in creek is OB.

HOLE 16 OB: OB marked by flags around creek.

HOLE 18: Disc must pass to the right of the mando marked with a white sign and black arrow. Any disc that misses mando gets a 1 stroke penalty and throws from the designated drop zone.

All other holes have no designated OB or Mandos. Any water encountered that is not specified in OB rules is considered casual relief.
