

LEVELS [of] QUESTIONS

1

Level One Questions

- Have one right answer
 - That answer can be found directly in the text
- ex: How many siblings does the character have?

2

Level Two Questions

- Have a few (2 or more) right answers
 - The answers are found directly in the text, but people can have different ideas
- ex: Which sibling does the character get along with best?

3

Level Three Questions

- Have many/multiple right answers
 - The answers are based on opinion, but the opinion has to be supported with evidence (A.W.E.)
- ex: Does the main character wish she were an only child? What about her behavior makes you think that?

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
