



2020-21 School Trustlands Final Report Crimson View Elementary

Fall 2021

Each year our school submits a School Trustlands Plan. The plan contains academic goal(s) and determines the allocation of the funds received annually from trustlands distribution.

GOAL:

All students in grades K-5 will improve their cumulative Acadience proficiency scores by 3%. Students in grades 3-5 will improve their grade level cumulative RISE proficiency by 3% - ELA to 79%, Mathematics to 84%, and Science to 92%

RESULTS:

ACADIENCE: Spring of 2019 - 87% of our K-5 students were identified as proficient on the Acadience EOY Benchmark. Our percentage of students identified as proficient in the spring of 2021 increased to 88%. This was an increase of 1%. While our overall percentage did increase, our Goal of a 3% increase was not met.

RISE: These scores are broken up into three subject areas, Math, ELA, Science.

As you can see our RISE scores did drop, fairly significantly. Our goal to increase each subject area by 3% was not met. This data trend was typical of schools in the state. One explanation is that this is of the detrimental effects of COVID-19 and how it has impacted students and our school directly.

SLT FUNDS:

Crimson View received \$63,451 for the 2020-21 academic school year. \$54,406 was spent according to our submitted plan with a carry over of \$9,045 to the 2021-22 school year. The bulk of CVES funds were spent on additional school personnel and technological devices for students. These funds are essential and so important to our school. Each of our students directly benefit as these funds are provided to our school and spent in a manner to impact and improve their educational opportunities.
