

WITHDRAWING MATERIALS (WEEDING)

1. Materials that no longer fit the stated service roles of the library, or have failed a challenge, will be withdrawn from the collection. This may include materials that are damaged, include obsolete information, or are no longer used. Decisions will be based on the CREW Method and the professional judgment of the library director.
2. Items withdrawn from the collection will be disposed by offering for sale to the public, sending to book reseller, or recycling. Materials failing a challenge may be given to another library (preferred), sold to the highest bidder in a silent auction or destroyed at the sole discretion of the director.
