



Student Response Boards – TK through 12

One way for Newcomers (and all other students) to demonstrate their comprehension is to use an individual white board or to make and use a response board. Just follow these steps:

Step One

Distribute to each student a piece of card stock (any color) and a 3-hole punched plastic sleeve.

Step Two

Students insert the card stock into the plastic sleeve.

Step Three

Using a dark color dry erase marker, student can draw or write their answer on the plastic.

Step Four

When the answer is complete, the student can hold up the response board for the teacher or other students to see.

Step Five

When done, students wipe off the dry erase ink with a cloth or paper towel, and insert the response board in their 3-ring binder.

***NOTE: Instead of, or in addition to the card stock, students can insert graph paper, graphic organizers, patterns, or worksheets.**
