PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

Between the parties:

WEST UNIVERSITY OF TIMIȘOARA, HEADQUARTERED IN Timișoara, 4 Vasile Pârvan Blvd., Timiș County, tax code 4250670, legally represented by the Rector Prof. Marilen Gabriel PIRTEA, PhD, confirmed by the Order of the Minister of Education no. 3697/01.02.2024, hereinafter referred to as UVT, and

Preamble

The parties agree to conclude this Partnership Agreement for the development of a sustainable framework of collaboration between the university and the economic and social environment in order to establish the conditions under which they will collaborate to promote mutual interests, as follows:

Art.1 Participation agreement

By signing this Partnership Agreement, the parties express their openness to the design and implementation of joint actions that will address:

- Students;
- Teachers;
- Graduates of the faculty, members of the alumni community (where applicable);
- Representatives from the partner organisation.

Art.2 Object of the Agreement

The object of this partnership is the collaboration between the two partners in the following actions:

- Establishing a permanent dialogue between the company and the university;
- Preparing students for a better insertion on the labor market by facilitating access to practice stages and internships, as well as informing them about the partner's job offers;
- Establishing the operational framework that allows the students of the Faculty of Mathematics and Computer Science of the West University of Timișoara to carry out practice stages/ internships at the partner's location or online;
- Identifying ways of cooperation in order to develop scientific research and technology transfer;
- Organizing in partnership programs for university students in order to inform, educate and support the professional training process (trainings, workshops, seminars, case study development, etc.);
- Organizing, with the logistical support of UVT, events at the initiative of the partner or the university, such as: round tables on various topics of interest, annual presentations of the company in which students participate, conferences, debates, etc.
- Support offered for strengthening the alumni community by participating in events, popularizing the alumni platform, identifying new alumni members, etc.

Art. 3 Principles of good practice of the partnership agreement

- (1) The Parties must consult each other regularly and inform each other on all aspects of the progress of the projects.
- (2) All partners must implement the activities in compliance with the highest professional and ethical standards.

Art. 4 Duration of the agreement

- (1) The duration of this agreement is year/s, a term that starts to run from the date of signing this document.
- (2) In the absence of written notice from one of the parties, at least 15 days before the expiry of the term of validity of this agreement, it shall be automatically extended for a further year, unless one of the parties notifies the other in writing its intention not to extend the partnership agreement.

Art. 5 Obligations of the partners

- (1) The obligations of the UVT partner, represented by the Faculty of Mathematics and Computer Science are the following:
 - a) Ensure and respect the visual identity of the partner;
 - b) To inform by specific means about cooperation with (partner name) (brochures presenting specializations, periodic newsletter, etc.);
 - c) To bring to the attention of the students and the partner (partner name) the topics for the practice stages / internships, in accordance with the practice stages/ internship syllabus specific to the specialization.
 - d) To promote joint events organized together with (partner name) on official promotion channels (the institution's website, Facebook page, etc.);
 - e) To provide, within the limits of available spaces, the logistics necessary for the organization of the various events organized in partnership.
- (2) Obligations of the partner (partner name) are as follows:
 - a) To collaborate and support the development of joint activities by providing expertise and resources for the activities in which he/she is involved (expert practitioners, practice tutors, guest speakers, mentors, etc.);
 - b) To analyze the possibility of supporting the students' activity in carrying out scientific/discipline projects through designated specialists, together with academic staff;
 - c) To transmit information that is of interest to the target group (students, teachers, UVT employees) to be disseminated on UVT's promotion channels;
 - d) To ensure the appropriate logistics for the development of the collaboration (where applicable).

Art. 6 Liability of the parties

- (1) Each party is responsible for the exact performance of the obligations assumed under this Agreement.
- (2) The parties are individually liable for the observance of copyright and related rights in the realization of the subject matter of this Agreement.

Art. 7 Confidentiality

- (1) The Parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of the information received during the course of carrying out the activities covered by this Partnership Agreement, except for information that is of a public nature, according to the law.
- (2) Each Party shall adopt its own measures to prevent the unauthorized use or disclosure of the information referred to in para. (1).
- (3) The information referred to in para. (1) may be used only for the purpose of fulfilling the obligations mentioned in this partnership agreement.

Art. 8 Processing of personal data

The Parties undertake to process the personal data obtained by virtue of the execution of this partnership agreement in compliance with the principles laid down in *Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation)*. Each of the Parties undertakes to implement reasonable physical, technical and administrative security measures so as to prevent incidents such as loss, inappropriate use, unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration or destruction of personal data. In the event of a data processing incident, each of the Parties must notify the other within 24 hours.

Art. 9 Final provisions

- (1) This Agreement shall have the character of a framework document and shall cover the entire activity of achieving the agreed common objectives. In order to carry out other actions derived from the framework objectives, the parties will conclude addenda to this agreement in which they will establish in concrete terms the responsibilities of each of them and the limits of carrying out the activities concerned.
- (2) At the level of the West University of Timișoara, this partnership agreement and any subsequent steps arising from its execution are subject to approval (signing) by the Vice-Rector responsible for institutional partnerships, European project management and entrepreneurship – Prof. Flavia Mirela Barna, PhD.
- (3) All communications between the parties regarding the signing and execution of this agreement shall be made in writing, at the following correspondence addresses:
