1. You have to watch this [video](#) about the fresco known as Rafael's "The School of Athens", and answer these questions.

- What other masterpiece of art was painting really close to these frescoes of Raphael?
- Raphael painted four frescoes in la “Stanza della Segnatura”, which were related to the four branches of human knowledge according the Renaissance mentality. What was the name of these four branches? In which branch Raphael incorporated the sciences?
- Do you think that four paintings are a good example of Humanism? Why?
- Who was the patron of Raphael at this moment? Do you think that this patron agreed with the intellectual movement of Humanism? Why?
- Relate the colors of the clothes of Plato and Aristotle with their different philosophy. Why Plato points out to heaven and Aristotle to the floor?
- Name the different Greek philosophers that appear in the School of Athens, explain why they are on the side of Plato or Aristotle, and finally name the Renaissance artist that is reincarnated in that Greek philosopher.
- Which Roman architectural ruins could have inspired Raphael for the buildings of his “School of Athens”?
