How many students does each counselor have?

Counseling caseloads are divided up among the eight counselors. Each counselor has between 265 and 270 students on their caseload. These numbers may change slightly throughout the year with new enrollments or withdrawals, but the numbers are divided as evenly as possible. This also ensures that students can remain with the same counselor from freshman to senior year.

Does the sign language course count as World Language?

American Sign Language does count as a World Language credit and can be used to meet graduation requirements. MCPS offers ASL up to Level 3.

What is the process for a student leaving school early for an appointment? Can the student leave on their own or does the parent come in and get them?
